SOURCE Former Japanese intelligence officer

- Former Major General TAKASHIMA Tatsuhiko (1559/1497/6591/1750) completely severed relations with the KAISEI Kikan in January or February 1953 and since then has devoted his time to his positions as an officer in various organizations and to writing articles on current affairs for magazines and other publications.
- TAKASHIMA is chief of the General Affairs Bureau of the Japan Defense Association (Gihon Doei Kyokai)¹, a director of the Japan Fatherland League (Aikyo Doei Kyokai)², an officer of the Japan National Defense Research Society (Gihon Doei Kyokai)³, and a councilor of the Fatherland Defense Coordinated Society (Gihon Doei Kyokai)⁴.
- Among TAKASHIMA's close friends at present are KIZAKI Tamoyuki (2306/1505/1634/0017), former Lieutenant General YAMATA Takao (3113/3944/1122/4471/5661), former Lieutenant General YAMAKA Shinichi (3944/0022/2450/0001), former Major General DOY Akio (0760/2446/2494/1133), former Colonel YAMAGUCHI Takahiro (2531/6752/0001/0914/6785), former Colonel YONEDA Kazuo (1231/2034/0007/3759), and former Colonel YONEDA Kazuo (8231/3025/0001/414626).

- Source Comment.** No information is available at present on this organization except that its leaders include YAMAGUCHI Takahiro and YAMAKA Shinichi.
- Field Comment.** According to G-2 JFFA files, the Fatherland Defense Coordinated Society is a nationalistic organization formed in mid-1951 with its headquarters and main strength in the Kansai area. It has about 70 branches and approximately 11,000 members. The organization is led, and reportedly financed personally, by KIZAKI Tamoyuki. TAKASHIMA visits Osaka once a month to keep in touch with its leaders and in July 1953 he delivered a lecture on national defense at a meeting sponsored by the organization (an outline of the speech is attached to the original only of this report).
