- The Divitual Kiken, headed by former Colonel MATTORI Takushiro (2591/6752/058;/0934/6745), became virtually inactive in 1952. Nost of the Kikan's personnel left the organization because it was short of funds.
- Although there were rumors in 1953 that relations were strained between NANTORI and TATSFII stichi (6591/1570/2837/0001), the two men actually cooperated correly in choosing former military personnel, particularly military operations specialists, for positions in the Mational Safety force (NSF)1.
- 3. imTTORI was overtly employed in 1952 and early 1953 as chief of the Materials Regulation Section of the Demobilization Europe (Fukuin kyoku Shirye Seiri Kacho). He resigned from this position in March or April 1953 and organized the Historical Facts Research Institute (Shijitsu henkyu Sho). The Institute is located at Tokyo-to, Sminjuku-ku, Ichigaya Sadohara-aho, 1 chame, 2.
- Of his friends among former military intelligence personnel, MATTORI is chesast to FOTANI Etsuo. NOTANI was once a member of the MATTORI Rikan and now regularly attends meetings of the Historical Facta Hesearch Institute. Although relations were strained between MATTORI and HITASHI Saburo (2651/0005/6745) prior to early 1952, the two have been on good terms since that times. HATTORI also maintains very friendly relations with former Colonel HATSHDATRA Televo (Sadataka) (2646/1627/1353/1031).
 - Field Comment. The strained relations probably studied from the fact that early in 1952 ANTORI opposed the YOSHIPA Government's plan of using the Mational Police Reserve (MPR) as the nucleus for a new army. HATTORI be-

- Field Comment. As predicted in ZJ-110, HATTORI was replaced in his Demobilisation Bureau position by his second in commend HARA Shiro (0626/0934/6745).
- 3 Source Comment. MASHIBHOTO also works for the CRC.
- 4 Source Comment. Former Colonel HORIBA Ensuo (8231/1034/0001/7160) also was connected with the Institute, but be died of an illness on 21 October 1953.

Field Comment. On one occasion Source referred to most of the men listed here as "connected" (kankei) with the Institute. At a later date Source schmitted a list of "membere" which included all the names except SURCHURA, TANAKA, and KOTANI.

- 5 Source Comment. It is believed the Institute receives some financial assistance from the CRG.
- 6 Field Comment. Source probably refers to the strained relations which reportedly began in 1949 when HATTORI published a severe criticism in the Shukan Asahi of HATASHI's book, A History of the Ground Forces in the Pacific War.
