Please note that HATTORI studied in France in 1934.</p> <p>Born - 2 January 1904 in Tokyo, Japan</p> <p>1922 - graduated from the Military Academy War College</p> <p>1930 - graduated from the War College</p> <p>1934 - studied in France, observer in Ethiopia during the Italian invasion</p> <p>1936 - served on the staff of the Mobilization and Organization Section of the Japanese Imperial General Staff (JIGS)</p> <p>1939 - Operations Officer with Kwantung Army Headquarters</p> <p>1940 - served with Army Education Section, Operations Section, JIGS</p> <p>1941 - December 1942; Chief, Operations Section, JIGS</p> <p>December 1942 - July 1944; Secretary for War Minister TOJO</p>
