FUFASING OFFICE

1964. ON 21 OCTOBER, FOURTH DAY OF TRIAL, DEFENDANT TARUM NAMED EERIK HEINE AS AUTHOR AND WRITER OF "BULLETINS".

4. BACKGROUND OF CASE: IN SEPTEMBER 1964 RUDOLF SIRGE, WELL KNOWN SOVIET-ESTONIAN AUTHOR, VISITED CANADA AS MEMBER CULTURAL DELEGATION. CANADIAN-ESTONIAN KARL EERME, THEN VICE PRESIDENT OF ESTONIAN CENTRAL COUNCIL BOARD (ECCB) HAD BEEN BOYHOOD FRIEND AND SCHOOLMATE OF SIRGE AND INVITED LATTER TO HIS HOME TO MEET A FEW CANADIAN ESTONIANS SOCIALLY. THIS INVITATION AND SO-CALLED "SECRET MEETING" IN EERME'S HOME WERE SUBSEQUENTLY SEVERLY CONDEWNED BY RIGHTWING ULTRA-NATIONALIST ESTONIAN EMIGRES, INCLUDING EERIK HEIME PARKMA, AS PRESIDENT OF ECCE DEMANDED EERME EXPLAIN HIS ACTIONS. EERME PRESENTED HIS REPORT AND RESIGNED AS VICE PRESIDENT. AFFAIR GREW INTO "CAUSE CELEBRE" WITH BEVENTEEN MAN ECCE DIVIDED BETWEEN RIGHT WING FACTION (LED BY HEIME) WHICH CONDEWNED THE OTHERS AS

ON 21 OCTOBER TARUM'S ATTORNEY PUT HIM ON STAND

IN DEFENSE. IN DIRECT EXAMINATION HE ASKED TARUM WHETHER HE KNEW IN 1964 WHO AUTHOR OF BULLETINS WAS. TARUM SAID NO. IN 1965? NO AGAIN. NOW? TARUM REPLIED, "YES, ON 18 OCTOBER IN YOUR (THE ATTORNEY'S) OFFICE EERIK HEINE CONFESSED HE WAS THE AUTHOR."

6. KEITH, CONFIDENT OF WINNING CASE FOR PARKMA AND TRASS, HAD NO INTENTION OF CALLING HEINE TO TESTIFY, BUT HAD STRONG FEELING DEFENSE WOULD DO SO. KEITH WAS AFRAID DEFENSE WOULD CALL HEINE AND PRESENT HIS LONG HEROIC BIOGRAPHY TO JURY, PAINTING HIM AS ANTI COMMUNIST FIGHTER AND EXPERT ON COMMUNISM, AND THEN LEAVE KEITH WITHOUT AMMUNITION FOR COUNTERATTACK. KEITH WANTED TO SHOW THAT HEINE'S ACTION IN CLANDESTINELY AUTHORING AND DISSEMINATING THE BULLETINS AND DISRUPTING THE ESTONIAN EMIGRATION WAS PROOF OF THE RAUS THESIS THAT HEINE WAS AGENT PROVOCATEUR. KEITH WANTED



TO "KISS OF DEATH" ASPECTS OF WOFACT INVOLVEMENT OR PARTICIPATION BY "WOFACT LAWYER" AS MIGHT BE LABELED. HOWEVER, DANGER WAS HEINE MIGHT APPEAR IN COURT AND EMERGE A HERO. / WAS CONCERNED THAT IF THAT HAPPENED, KEITH MIGHT ANNOUNCE TO PRESS HE HAD CALLED ON RAUS' LAWYER FOR ASSISTANCE AGAINST HEINE AND HAD GOT NOTHING. TENTATIVE CONCLUSION WAS THAT/ OR HIS ASSOCIATE / SHOULD GO TO TORONTO AND CONSULT WITH KEITH PRIVATELY, TAKING ONLY "OVERT" FILE MATERIAL (PLEADINGS DEPOSITION, TRANSCRIPTS OF HEARINGS, ETC) BUT STAYING OUT OF COURTROOM AND AVOIDING ANY OPEN INVOLVEMENT IN CASE. GENERAL COUNSEL FELT THIS MIGHT BE FAVORABLE BREAK IN HEINE CASE AND IT WOULD BE ERROR NOT TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF IT.
