The following is the latest SMABOVE report concerning the status of MANNO:

1. MANNO now states that he has no relatives residing in Estonia since his father, Gustav, came to Canada approximately one year ago. He has apparently lost his fear of reprisal at the hands of Soviets, and is taking steps to correct his name to MANNO on his driver's license, at his place of work, etc. Checks in late 1965 as well as a recent follow-up report fail to reveal any emigre activity.

2. Recently MANNO was asked to again recount his experiences and activities during the years 1941 to 1944. These were compared with his account given to [redacted] in May 1960 in Sweden and no discrepancies were noted. We intend to maintain contact with MANNO and will pass on any information of consequence.
