Chief, SB				<p>The background of the attached is as follows: On 8 February 1967 RAUS told me that he and [redacted] had discussed the idea of their having lunch with Orr Kelly, the reporter for the Star, in order "to get to know him" and perhaps make him a little more favorable to our side of the case. I told RAUS that I had no objection to the idea but doubted that it was worth the trouble; and at any rate [redacted] would have to clear it with OGC. (Attached is a copy of my memorandum for the record which covers this.) I subsequently told [redacted] what RAUS had said and to expect a call from [redacted] concerning the idea. On 15 February [redacted] called to ask me to make sure that RAUS had not and would not see Kelly. RAUS informed me that he had not met with Kelly or anyone else, will not in the future and certainly would not have done so unaccompanied by [redacted] or [redacted]. The idea originally came from RAUS who, being personally involved in the case, continues to seek ways to better our position.</p>

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Heine v. Raus

1. I called [redacted] today to express our concern that Juri Raus should be interviewed by Orr Kelly. I expressed the hope that firm plans had not been made. [redacted] assured me they had not and he was quick to appreciate our disinclination to go along with what apparently had been Raus' proposal for counteracting the publicity given Heine. He stated that when Raus first mentioned it, he had attempted to point up the problems involved, particularly that Raus would be unable to give Kelly any meaningful information consistent with the position that he had maintained in Court.

2. While [redacted] led me to believe that the idea may have emanated from within the Agency, [redacted] (SB/CI), who has succeeded [redacted] as Raus' contact, has assured me that it was not his but rather Raus'. I have asked [redacted] to tell Raus that we are opposed to his being interviewed by Kelly or anyone else.
