This, of course, is no defence to a libel action, but it could influence a court into thinking that the storm he kicked up in the Estonian community in Toronto was a very local tempest in a very local teapot.

If he manages to create this impression, he could easily escape with nominal damages.

Anything that you can advise me about that would tend to unmask this man will be greatly appreciated.
