Since this man is not an agent or prospective agent, virtually none of part B is applicable. Main point of this name check was to get any local info on a man who was to be hired by Heitner for overt activities. We made the check as a precaution in view of the fact that he might eventually gain some limited knowledge that Heitner is receiving funds for his newspaper from foreign (not govt) sources. In view of the bureaucratic red tape necessary to getting a clearance now I don't see any point in going farther than a local check at this time. Was anything derogatory found out locally from any source concerning the two prospective employees of Heitner? I would appreciate a short summary of whatever was found out.
