- 1. LT. GEN. ADOL HEUSINGER, LEADING MILITARY ADVISER OF THE WEST GERMAN GOVERNMENT, IS CONVINCED THAT ABD EL-MASSER WILL NEVER ACCEPT THE PROPOSALS MADE BY THE 18-NATION CONFERENCE ON THE SUEZ QUESTION. HE IS ALSO CONVINCED THAT THE BRITISH AND FRENCH WILL NOT RESORT TO THE USE OF FORCE; HE BELIEVES THAT IT IS NOW TOO LATE TO USE FORCE, AND SAYS THE BRITISH AND FRENCH SHOULD HAVE PARACHUTED TROOPS INTO THE AREA AND SEIZED THE CANAL AS SOON AS THE TROUBLE STARTED, AND THINKS THIS WOULD HAVE PREVENTED ALL THE DIFFICULTIES.
- 2. HEUSINGER CONSIDERS THE SUEZ CRISIS MORE ACUTE EVEN THAN THE KOREAN WAR, BUT SAYS THAT AN EXCLUSIVELY POLITICAL SOLUTION MUST NOW BE FOUND. THE BRITISH AND FRENCH, HE SAYS, REALIZE THAT THE USE OF FORCE WOULD LEAD NASSER TO BLOW UP THE CANAL AND WOULD CAUSE THE ARAB NATIONS TO BAND TOGETHER TO BLOCK THE SHIFMENT OF OIL; OBVIOUSLY NEITHER GREAT BRITAIN NOR FRANCE IS WILLING TO TAKE THIS RISK. ON THE OTHER HAND. THE FRENCH GENERAL ELY TOLD HEUSINGER THAT HE FEARED THAT FAILURE TO ACHIEVE A

- 3. HEUSINGER REMARKED THAT IT IS CLEAR THAT THE SOVIET UNION WILL COME TO EGYPT'S AID IF HOSTILITIES OCCUR. IF NASSER SHOULD WIN, HEUSINGER IS CONVINCED THE EFFECT WOULD BE TO UNITE THE ARAB WORLD, WHICH WOULD MEAN TLAT IN A SHORT TIME ISRAEL WOULD BE ELIMINATED FROM THE NEAR EASTERN PICTURE.
- 4. HEUSINGER COMPARED NASSER TO HITLER, STATING THAT A DICTATOR ALWAYS HAS
 THE UPPER HAND IN SITUATIONS OF THIS KIND: THE DEMOCRACIES MUST CONSULT, NEGOTIATE,
 AND GAIN THE SUPPORT OF PUBLIC OPINION BEFORE THEY CAN ACT, AND THEN IT IS USUALLY
 TOO LATE.
