<p>1. Request routine file check on <u>Wolfgang HOEHER</u> or <u>Wolfgang HOHER</u>, Berlin-Kreisberg, Skalitzerstr., telephone 61 42 60. We find a <u>Wolfgang HOHER</u> listed in the 1943 Berlin directory as "Hauptmann der Schutzpolizei", living in Berlin-Kreuzberg, Wienerstr. 14d. POB please check Zipper files. The reasons for this request are given below.</p> <p>2. ☐ ☐ reported recently that Horst Kirwes, a German official of the SAG Main headquarters in Berlin-Weissensee, had confided to him "some months ago" that he was working for the Bonn intelligence service, reporting through <u>Wolfgang HOEHER</u>, Berlin-Kreuzberg, phone as above.</p> <p>4. A number of possibilities of operational interest suggest themselves as a result of the above notes. One possibility is that the Kirwes/HOEHER chain is a Zipper operation. This might explain some the recent Zipper reports in the SAG field. In any case, it would be interesting if we could obtain definite proof that Kirwes is a western agent, as a check on some of ☐ ☐ statements.</p>
