It is reported that Wolfgang Edher, who was apparently kidnapped at Soviet orders in February 1953, is preparing a second series of revelations concerning his knowledge of Western intelligence operations in East Germany. He is said to be collaborating with a Russian mamed Kararov on a volume to be entitled "The Cold War" (Ser kalte Krieg).

Security against the "Gehlen organization" and other intelligence agencies allegedly controlled by the Western Allies, with the attendant publicity, indicates that a drive is under way to compile such information for propaganda purposes (as distinguished from the normal secret exploitation of counter-espionage material). The publication of exposes this subject could be preparatory to their use as an extensive diversion issue at the Four-Power Conference. The Russians may intend to hold the question of intelligence activities in East Germany in reserve for possible use as a time-consuming blind alley with favorable propaganda aspects, to be activities and when it seems tack mally advantageous.
