On 14 October 1955, examination of the resords of the Regional Registry, Region I, 66th CIC Group, STUTICART (NY/1503), October the following information concerning one Alfred BESTZINGER who may be the since person mentioned by SUBJECT to be in charge of the CEHLEN Organisation in southern West Germany:

Dossier number I-43295, Subject: Potential Informants, which contains a letter from Headquarters Counter Intelligence Corps, United States Forces, Baropean Theater, to Chief, Counter Intelligence Corps, Region I, STUTTCART, file 383 (CIC/S-3/FC), dated 22 July 1946. The letter states that one Alfred HENTEINGER, KARLSRUHE/Baden (NV 5528), Germany, Gerwegstrasse 36, in care of, ZIMMERIE, had been approached by CIC, Sub-Region KARLSRUHE to work for CIC. The letter further states that RESTRINGER was already in the employ of another agency. The 2nd Indormement to the basic letter, file I-6.1-27, dated 9 angust 1946 revealed that BENTZINGER was working for Special Projects, FRANKFURT (MA 7752), Germany.
