1. Subject was never traced with PCB in EGBA-15764, 20 July 1954.
2. We have a record of Subject as Joseph ROSAKTA, born 8 April 1904 in Rybnik/OS; living at Insterburnallee 24, Berlin-Charlottenburg; KK No. 124/7717/46; in the attachment to XHA-3601, 1 May 1953 (sent to BOB), in connection with the Wolfgramm HOESHER Case.
3. The following possible traces are also mentioned:
  - A. SO-85598, 16 April 1952: In October 1951 a Frau ROSANSKY was involved in a carter deal for the SONICE firm on behalf of the Hungarian Government with the Cologne firm of Otto WOLFF. WOLFF's proposals were initially turned down by Frau ROSANSKY on instructions from Bucharest.
  - B. EGLA-4847, 17 January 1952 (not sent BOB): In attachment to this dispatch (briefing of V-9701), a Josef ROSNOWSKI of Szczecin was mentioned as not acquainted with V-9701, but believed to be a UB man by the people of Stettin.
