On 3 November 1955, Source "B" revealed that Source "A" was the addressee of a letter from Wolfgang HOKHER, LEIPZIG (US 1891), East Germany, Thomassinstrasse 2. The letter is translated as follows:

Dear Comrade.....

30 October 1955

Did you wait for a letter from me? Well, I had very much work these last weeks, and I hope that you will kindly forgive me, my laziness in writing.

In connection with our last conversation, I cannot tell you that everything can be arranged the way you desired it. I am glad about that because you thereby are also helped considerably.

I would now like to ask you to spare the time for a meeting with me on approximately 12 November. Please inform me of your disposition concerning this so that I can send you what is necessary.

How are you doing; how is the family? I hope that you are without further worries in view of the present circumstances.

As mentioned, I myself am overburdened with work. One then forgets many private.....(illegible)

Hoping for an early reunion, I greet you most cordially
