On 17 November 1955, Source "A" was interviewed and revealed the following information:

a. He had received a letter from SUBJECT on 10 or 11 November 1955, in which HOEHER had related that due to a heavy work load he would like Source "A" to cancel his trip to LEIPZIG until the week end of 19-20 November 1955. Providing the new dates were agreeable to Source "A", HOEHER would send the necessary documents. Source "A" had answered the letter and informed HOEHER that the later date was acceptable.

b. On 17 November 1955, Source "A" received an Aufenthaltsgenehmigung (Visitors Permit) for the purpose of visiting LEIPZIG. The permit was valid for the dates of 18 November through 20 November 1955. (B-2).
