SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

INFORMATION

1. Source received a letter, dated 17 January 1956 from Robert KETELLE, Organisationsleiter (Organization Leader) of the National Democratic Party, residing in LEIPZIG (SU 1071), East Germany, Leipzigerstrasse 67, in which he was requested to try to come to the LEIPZIG Fair and to bring two or three associates with him. General Gotthilf MESSER, HOCHBURG (SU 4426), Germany, was also invited to attend.

2. Source recently received a telephone call from Dieter KRING, STUTTGART/Walzingen (SU 0871), Schaeckenhofstrasse 21, presently studying in MUNICH (PG 9059), in which KRING stated that he had received an invitation to the LEIPZIG Fair and indicated to Source that he planned to attend the Fair.

3. Source learned through a telephone call received from one Christian KOCH, MUNICH/Reck (SU 2778), that KOCH had also received an invitation to the LEIPZIG Fair. KOCH indicated to Source that Hermann SCHMID and Georg PIALA, both residing in OWEN/Reck (SU 3382), had also received invitations to LEIPZIG and that SCHMID, PIALA and he were planning to attend.

4. It is very possible that all of the persons who attended the convention of the Arbeitsgemeinschaft fuer Bertheuer Soldaten (Association of German Soldiers), in BERLIN (SU 9220), in July 1955, have received invitations to LEIPZIG. There were over 60 persons from Baden-Wuerttemberg at the BERLIN convention.

5. Source will depart STUTTGART (SU 1303), by train for LEIPZIG at 0645 hours, 29 February 1956 to attend the LEIPZIG Fair. Source will head an unofficial delegation of persons from the STUTTGART area. Included in the group will be Christian KOCH, Prits HUPFER, HUPFER/Reck, Frau Margaret SUNDHAGEN, STUTTGART, Neue Weinsteige 45, Dieter KRING, and Source. Major General Gotthilf MESSER, will not attend the meeting in LEIPZIG. KRING will depart MUNICH by train on 29 February 1956 and will join the group of persons from STUTTGART at ROF (GA 0879), where all must transfer to an interregional train, which will take them to LEIPZIG.

Dear Comrade:

Thank you very much for your letter of 7 February 1956.

I am happy about your answer and inform you that we are awaiting your arrival on 27 February, so that you will have time for LEIPZIG on 26, 29 February and 1 and 2 March.

We are expecting very many guests this time and have planned everything so that, in spite of the large number of visitors who will come to LEIPZIG, everyone will be provided with the best of accommodations. Therefore, we ask you, if at all possible, to keep the appointment from 27 February to 2 March.

In order to arrange the financial question at the same time, we inform you, that you should pay the travel cost to LEIPZIG and for the Fair identification, which is available in your city at the Craftsmen's Council or Industry and Trade Council. The cost of your stay here and for your return trip will be taken care of by me. In case you have some difficulty in this respect, I would be much obliged to you, if you would write me immediately. Eventually I must send you the authority to stay here, for which I will need the information concerning your location and your birthdate.

My friend in LEIPZIG, Herr FRANZEL, has written Herr SCHAILER and his wife and invited both. I hopefully ask if you would call Herr SCHAILER again, and ask him if he will be able to visit us under the revised conditions.

Let me know right away, what the probable time of your arrival will be so that I can meet you at the main railroad station in LEIPZIG. I will arrange everything else with Comrade HUGNER. With best wishes I remain until we meet again.

and SEP (Sozialistische Reichspartei - Socialist Reichs Party). On 18 May 1952 he was reported as having been in the SS (Selbte Staffel - Elite Guard), and as being Chairman of the SEP in HEUFFEN. On 28 May 1952, he attended a meeting of Westdeutsches Friedenskomitee - West German Freedom Committee) in STUTTGART/Lofen. KOCH has been a member of the Executive Committee of the Ortsgruppe (Town Group), HEUFFEN since 1951 and has held membership meetings and open air meetings of the SEP in the past two months in HEUFFEN. On 23 June 1952, KOCH attended an SEP meeting in STUTTGART.

II. Gottfried GRILLSMAYER, aka Friedl; aka Gottfried GRILLSMAYER, born 18 March 1919 in BOHR AM PRAN (now, Austria), present address GAUTING (FU 7726), near MUNICH was an Oberhauptfuehrer (Colonel) in the Hitler Youth. He was chief of the Department of Education and was interned on 30 May 1945 and released on 22 November 1946 from DARMSTADT Camp 91. Since 1946 he has been working as a textile merchant. Dossier, File I-17093, was forwarded to Agency "A" in December 1955.
