On 20 March 1956, Source "B" revealed a letter addressed to Source "A", from SUBJECT, postmarked LKIPKIG (US 1891), East Germany. A translation of the letter is as follows:

I was very glad about your brief greeting. I hope that our reunion in ~~WEST~~ will be very nice.

Send me a telegram in time.

Greetings to all, and especially to your dear wife.
