AUSSERMEION

1. Source received am Easter Greeting card from SUBJECT on 31 March The purpose of the sard was to render Easter greetings to Source and family. Source had written BOMERR shortly after returning to Stuttgart (ST 1303) from the Leipzig Pair, thanking MORERE for the invitation to the Pair. Source has not received may mail from the East Zone from any of the personn execciated with the ABS (Arbeitsmensinesheft fuer Deutsche Soldaten - Association of Sermon Soldiers), other than the foregoing ourd and a letter free Bohert Bueller, Organization Chief of the EDF (National-Demokratische Partei - National Democratic Party), which was received just after Source's return to Stuttgart. Basiler inquired as to how Source had enjoyed his visit to the Leipzig Pair and if Source had returned home sufely. (Source "A-IT") (3-5)

2. At approximately 0915 hours, 2 June 1956, Source was contacted at the Motel Maria, Priedrichetrasee, East Berlin by SURJECT.

a. SUBJECT teld Source that he was staying at the Johanneshof (hotel) in East Serlin. SUBJECT expressed disappointment that Source had not written him for quite some time and that Source had not informed SUBJECT that he was going to be in Berlin. Source told MCSERR that he believed that SUBJECT. was perhaps angry because of statements Source had made at the Leipzig Pair in Fet mary 1956, in which Source had Acrided the East Zone for their many unfullfilled progines to the people. SUBJECT said that he was not sagry about these remarks. SUBJECT purchased a used Volksvagen and he has been traveling extensively in the East Zone. SUBJECT did not elaborate upon the reasons or places of travel. SUBJECT is suffering from a blood circulatory ailment and plans to take a six-week ours treatment in Bad Elster (UR 0574), East Germany in the near future. SUBJECT will write Source from that location. SUBJECT asked if Source and his wife were going to attend the Eerbet Amestellung (Fall Pair) to be held in Leipsig (US 1891) in August or September 1956, to which Source answered that he was not certain whether he would be able to get time off from his work. SUBJECT promised to send Bource an invitation to the Fair. SUBJECT sentioned nothing concerning his work, and did not ask Source to do anything for him.

b. Source excused himself at 1000 hours in order to be at a meeting of the ADS (Arbeitsgemeinschaft fuer Deutsche Soldaten - Association of German Soldiers) and SUBJECT is believed to have returned to the Johannesbof Hotel. Source is of the opinion that perhaps another meeting of ADS, probably rank in file sembers, was going on at the Johanneshof. Source did not go to the Johanneshof during his stay in East Berlin. (Source "A-IV") (B-3)
