SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

AUSSERMBIDK

1. Source received an Easter Greeting card from SUBJECT on 31 March 1956. The purpose of the card was to render Easter greetings to Source and family. Source had written BOEKER shortly after returning to Stuttgart (IV 1303) from the Leipzig Fair, thanking BOEKER for the invitation to the Fair. Source has not received any mail from the East Zone from any of the persons associated with the ADS (Arbeitsgemeinschaft fuer Deutsche Soldaten - Association of German Soldiers), other than the foregoing card and a letter from Robert Mueller, Organisation Chief of the NDP (National-DEMokratische Partei - National Democratic Party), which was received just after Source's return to Stuttgart. Mueller inquired as to how Source had enjoyed his visit to the Leipzig Fair and if Source had returned home safely. (Source "A-IV") (B-5)

2. At approximately 0915 hours, 2 June 1956, Source was contacted at the Hotel Adria, Friedrichstrasse, East Berlin by SUBJECT.

a. SUBJECT told Source that he was staying at the Johanneshof (hotel) in East Berlin. SUBJECT expressed disappointment that Source had not written him for quite some time and that Source had not informed SUBJECT that he was going to be in Berlin. Source told BOEKER that he believed that SUBJECT was perhaps angry because of statements Source had made at the Leipzig Fair in February 1956, in which Source had derided the East Zone for their many unfulfilled promises to the people. SUBJECT said that he was not angry about these remarks. SUBJECT purchased a used Volkswagen and he has been traveling extensively in the East Zone. SUBJECT did not elaborate upon the reasons or places of travel. SUBJECT is suffering from a blood circulatory ailment and plans to take a six-week cure treatment in Bad Elster (UR 0574), East Germany in the near future. SUBJECT will write Source from that location. SUBJECT asked if Source and his wife were going to attend the Herbst Ausstellung (Fall Fair) to be held in Leipzig (US 1891) in August or September 1956, to which Source answered that he was not certain whether he would be able to get time off from his work. SUBJECT promised to send Source an invitation to the Fair. SUBJECT mentioned nothing concerning his work, and did not ask Source to do anything for him.

b. Source excused himself at 1000 hours in order to be at a meeting of the ADS (Arbeitsgemeinschaft fuer Deutsche Soldaten - Association of German Soldiers) and SUBJECT is believed to have returned to the Johanneshof Hotel. Source is of the opinion that perhaps another meeting of ADS, probably rank in file members, was going on at the Johanneshof. Source did not go to the Johanneshof during his stay in East Berlin. (Source "A-IV") (B-5)
