4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 24 January 1957, Source A-POSTUT was interviewed at Stuttgart (NY 1303), Germany and revealed the following information:

Source stated that he has had no contact with SUBJECT since August 1956, at which time they met in Eisenach (WB 9349), East Germany. (This information has been reported). Source indicated that he did receive a Christmas greeting card from HOEHER. He claimed further, that he had had no contact with any other persons in the East Zone who are connected with SUBJECT or the ADS (Arbeitsgemeinschaft Deutscher Soldaten - Association of German Soldiers).

Source indicated that former German General Gottlob Berger had received a written invitation from SUBJECT to attend the Leipzig Messe (Fair) to be held in March 1957. Source believes he may also receive such an invitation.
