I. REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 24 January 1957, Source A-FOSFOT was interviewed at Stuttgart (HW 1303), Germany and revealed the following information:

Source stated that he has had no contact with SUBJECT since ingust 1956, at which time they set in Risemach (HB 9349), East Germany. (This information has been reported). Source indicated that he did receive a Christman greeting card from HOEHER. He claimed further, that he had hed no contact with any other persons in the East Zone who are connected with SUBJECT or the ADS (Arbeitagemeinschaft Deutschar Soldaten - Association of German Soldiers).

Source indicated that former German General Gottlob Berger had received a written invitation from SUBJECT to attend the Leipsig Resse (Fair) to be hold in March 1957. Source believes he may also receive much an invitation.
