MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Alexander WAAG



*passed in 88/6/10
Cordell*

1. During the past month or two, subject has been sick. The nature of the illness was not mentioned in [redacted] processes. However, he is now back on his feet and ready to start working for UPWING.

2. Subject has been assigned the number V-15800 and works for District 12. He apparently has several individuals working for him. The first case he is to be given is that of Hans ALMSBERGER, a former agent of SICO Region I who is being turned over to UPWING.

3. UPWING is going to run the ALMSBERGER case as an IS case. The desk officer in headquarters is alias HELLER. The DS man handling the case is alias PENCHER. In turn, the agent leader is V-15300, and the agent himself is V-1802. V-1802 was listed in our files as having been dropped in 1951, but he obviously has been reactivated as an agent of V-15300.

4. A note in HELLER's files seen by [redacted] is that while an ISV official, subject was in very close touch with Erwin STREIBER, chief of the Wuertemberg LKA. This could be significant in that STREIBER might have been ALBERT's contact in the LKA Wuertemberg Baden. Undersigned intends to press STREIBER until the answer to this particular problem is received.
