REMARKS FOR THE RECORD

TO WHOM: Alexander WAG

C.E.

1. During the past month or two, Subject has been sick. The nature of the illness was not mentioned in [] presence. However, he is now back on his feet and ready to start working for UPSWING.

2. Subject has been assigned the number V-15800 and works for Dientstelle 12. He apparently has several individuals working for him. The first case he is to be given is that of Hans ALBERTER, a former agent of NCIC Region I who is being turned over to UPSWING.

3. UPSWING is going to run the ALBERTER case as an IF case. The desk officer in headquarters is alias HELLER. The DS man handling the case is alias PECHTEL. In turn, the agent leader is V-15800, and the agent himself is V-1002. V-1002 was listed in our files as having been dropped in 1951, but he obviously has been reactivated as an agent of V-15800.

4. A note in HELLER's files seen by [] is that while an IIV official, Subject was in very close touch with Erwin STREIBEL, chief of the Waerttemberg IKA. This could be significant in that STREIBEL might have been ALBERTER's contact in the IKA Waerttemberg Section. Undersigned intends to press HELLER until the answer to this particular problem is received.
