SUBJECT: AU REMEDIA Case - Discussion with a REIMPE on morning of 100/00/00

- 2. The UPSWITE handling agent (GUTMAIN (True: MAHLMAIN, V-1802) will be in the Kaffee Sitel, Pliensaustr 18, Esslingen at 1100 hours, wriday, 5 April. GUTMAIN will be wearing a gray suit, white shirt, dark blue solid color tie, will be reading "Die Weltwoche", holding the paper so a visitor entering the Kaffee Bitel can see the newspaper titl; head.
- 3. The CIC handling agent should approach GUTMANN and say, "Kommon Sie aus Stuttgart?", whereupon GUTMANN must reply "Nein, aus Karlsruhe". The CIC handling agent will then ask whether he may sit at the table, and will then produce a totem consisting of half a Lotto blank, which GUTMANN can match.
