For some time there have been/troop movements in the area
Spang-Daulea, Bitburg and Hahn.

Two squadrons of jet planes were transferred from Fuerstenfeldbruck
to Bitburg. A group of fighter-bombers from Tripoli arrived at Hahn.

This information is from/German employee of Bitburg named _____.

The information concerning the deposit of atomic weapons at B 51
Kanz-Saarburg (sic) can be considered confirmed. On the basis of an
article in the "Trierischen Volksfreund" of the 16 of March, 1957,
I visited the restaurant ~~in~~ which these employed there (sic)
frequent and talked about the article to them. In these conversations
remarks such as "We know that a long time"; "They can't fool us.", etc.,
were made. The article caused the population of Trier to become quite
worried, since it was not clear to them that they are sitting on a
powderkeg. It is known in Trier that a number of business men
have built deep and strong shelters. The ~~AMEX~~ Antony company is
selling ray-proof protective paints, and large quantities of these
were delivered to Bitburg and Hahn. "

- ☐ received various one-way messages by radio, one of April, 1957,
asks about the construction worker at Bitburg. There were also other
reminders about this man, indicating Enemy interest in this particular man.
