SUBJECT: Possible Identification of Vehicle from Leipzig  
by Dieter HOEHER

1. On Sunday morning, 17 November 1957, as he and his sister were walking to a news-stand to buy some papers and magazines, at approximately 1000 hours, Dieter HOEHER reported that he saw a Volkswagen, blue in color, with red upholstered interior, license SV 25-36. This vehicle, according to Source, belongs to a fnu pnu Dr., who keeps it in a garage just across the street from the HOEHER residence in Leipzig. The Dr. is academic, not medical. According to Dieter and his mother, his father was acquainted with the Dr., but they did not know the extent or nature of the acquaintance, or whether the DR. was in any way connected with the father's RIS work.

2. Under insistent questioning, Dieter insisted that the vehicle was absolutely the one from Leipzig, he was positive of the identification.

3. No BOB trace on license SV 25-36.
