1. Attached are the following reports:
 - a. Summary of information, subject as above, dated 6 May 58.
 - b. Fourteen (14) report reports, subject as above, dated 3 April 58.

2. Source of the information in the attached reports is Jacob HANLEY, born 13 December 1924 in Wanta, Egypt. Upon volunteering the information, subject executed a signed statement to the effect that he had not been and was not then employed by CIC, and that he further understood if he represented to anyone that he was or had been employed by CIC, he would be subject to prosecution under existing German laws.

3. The attached reports are being furnished to you in view of its interest in Gottlob "ANNON", born 16 July 1896, Dorstetten, Kreis Reidenheim, who with several associates, is mentioned by Subject, and in view of other elements not within the scope of the mission of CIC.

4. On 18 April 1958, Subject went to Camp Welka, Nurnberg, under auspices of the American Friends Service Committee, Stuttgart, Alexanderstrasse 69, an affiliate of the International Rescue Committee, Geneva, Switzerland and the United States Escapee Program. Subject's goal is to obtain recognition as a political refugee from Egypt, to immigrate to the United States, and/or to effect alien enlistment in the United States Army.

5. On 14 May 1958, CIC was advised Subject had become involved in a fracas in the Nurnberg area and was under arrest by the Nurnberg police. It was reported that Subject would be prosecuted on charges of assault and battery and would probably be sentenced to three to six months imprisonment.

6. Subject is of no operational interest to CIC and no further action relative to him or to him or to other personalities mentioned in the attached reports is anticipated by CIC.
