1. Subject was closely associated with an UPSVING met in Barlin from approximately 1949 to 1953. His case officer for this period later turned cut to be a Soviet Peactration Apeat of UPSAING. He bave no evidence to prove that BURNER was aware of or an accomplice of this Soviet Penstration Agent; however, the facts, as we know them, would not rule out this possibility. UPSCING could probably provide additional information on this matter, but it is very doubtful that UPSVIDE would to so.

- 2. In view of the fact that HUESMER, contrary to the information contained in reference, is known to have been employed by UPSKIRG as late as February, 1954, it is presumed that UPENING was convinced that BURBIER was not implicated in the case of the Sowiet Penetration; on the other hund, it must be noted that UPSEIRS in 1954 was not then army that UPS/ING had been penetrated by a Soviet agent. They thought BURBER's case officer simply had been kidentyped by the opposition. Under these circumstances, it is unlikely that UPSKING would have considered seriously or critically the relationship which existed between BURNER and the Soviet Penetration Agent.
- If the Canadians decide to query UPS/ING on HIMMER connections with them, it is requested that so mention be made of the fact that we have passed the above information to E. It is suggested that the Canadians be especially critical of any UPS THO information they may receive, should a query be made. It is felt that UPSSIBO would be very conservative in their answers and not really frank.
- 4. POB OHLY: Beadquarters officers familiar with the case have expressed their doubts that BURBARR was completely unwitting that his UPS-IBG case officer was, indeed, a Soviet Paratrution Agent. One officer advised against the Canadians' quering UPS-VIBG; for it is felt UPSVIR would not be frank in their measure. This officer want further to recommend that the Canadians drop their consideration of admitting BUZER permanently to Camada. If the decision were left to this officer be would not admit HUERNER to the United Status.
- 5. We would be interested in knowing whether or not BUEBERA will be allowed to remain in Canada permanently.
