Athens BIPO Centre: Chief of this is the "Polizeiattache" HOESSELBARTH whom MERZ saw frequently during his <sup>two</sup> stays in Athens during summer and autumn 1943. Many agents of Amt VI gather in this office;

HOESSELBARTH: A Saxon from Dresden. Has pronounced Saxon accent Polizei attache in Athens or Sipo official. Previously Gestapo or SD official in Dresden. SS Hauptsturmfuhrer (Captain) Great friend of Hahnel of Amt II and Dr. Graefe of Amt VI, RSHA. MERZ reported to Hoesselbarth all details about EAM and other Greek secret societies, which were immediately passed on to Amt VI. Born circa 1903, ca 172 cm tall, stout build, dark blond or brown hair. Dark complexion, dark eyes and dark heavy eyebrows.
