Although we incorporate into MLB UJVENTURE files all new names of CATIDE employees revealed through that organization's COSMIC and SIGINT clearance trace requests, we no longer report them in the periodic dispatches on UJVENTURE notebook changes and additions, since they are in the normal course of events carded when they are first reported. Born 19 September 1903 in Dresden, ^(See 20)
CIT East Germany

He performed a security document checking task for CATIDE in Hannover on 25 December 1963. (See EGFA-41147, 7 February 1964.) His V-card at MLB #8707, indicates that he was used by CATIDE as a letter drop in Berlin in 1950 and was dropped by them on 1 March 1951. The date of his reemployment is not known to M¹. A card in Munich's general files refers to a memo written by on 22 March 1956, stating that COSSMANN of the BFV's refugee office in Berlin was "as we have long been aware" also a paid member of CATIDE.

- c. Christina ^X * GEHLEN (201-^{W 201}) ^{SELF}
Born 5 March 1940 in Leipzig,
CIT East Germany

This daughter of Giovanni GEHLEN working in the foreign liaison unit for Dr. Hans WINTER SWILDEN, who reported in February 1964 that her permanent assignment had not been determined.

- d. Otto ^{FR} * GOTTANKA, Dipl. Ing
*GERAU CIT GERMANY
Born 31 August 1907

He joined the scientific and technical evaluations unit at CATIDE in 1961 as a specialist in aircraft and weapons systems.

- e. Ellis ^{FR} * KOEPL ^{SELF} CIT GERMANY
DPOB Unknown
Residing Munich, Freseniusstr. 79 ^{W 600}

She is a translator in the Dienststelle headed by Hans-Jochem RUDLOFF, ^{FR} CRUFF, the unit which analyzes the free world press.

- f. (Dr) Wilfried * KRALLERT
Born 23 January 1912 in Vienna, Austria
CIT GERMANY

Although Munich registry contained a 201-file for KRALLERT, he was not represented in UJVENTURE files as a CATIDER until CATIDE requested a BDC trace (EGMA-64567, 13 May 1964).

- g. Inu ^X * KRAUSE (201-^{W 201})
*KRATTOWITZ CIT GERMANY
Born circa 1920

This man joined CATIDE circa 1963 as assistant to the deputy chief of air evaluations. He is a Luftwaffe major on active duty and is generally considered the likely successor to Hans-Curt von SPONECK *SPOHR, should *SPOHR be given a new assignment.

- h. Inu ^X * KULLAU (201-^{W 201}) *KLINKAV
DPOB Unknown CIT GERMANY

As of February 1964 he was deputy chief of naval evaluations.

- i. (Cmdr) Helmut ^X * MANSECK
*MAGER CIT GERMANY
DPOB Unknown

He joined the naval evaluations unit early in 1964 and became its chief when Captain Gunter POSER *PRECHTEL, went to Bonn. (See paragraph 4 h.)

Born circa 1925

Having joined CATIDE late in 1963, he assumed command of the Special Forces School at Bad Aibling, vice MATTERHAUPT (phonetic), #MOHSEN, early in 1964. Previously PICHERT commanded an engineer battalion at Wildflecken, West Germany.

✓ k. (Dr. Karl # RAWER

DPOB Unknown

The chief of the Breisach Ionospheric Institute, he, like others working for the institute, became a CATIDE employee when CATIDE absorbed the institute in 1963. Dr. RAWER is directly subordinate to Johannes CROME, #CAPPEL, chief of the communications unit of CATIDE.

1. ✓ l. # REICHHARDT

Born circa 1948

In February 1964 he replaced fnu ALBRECHT, #ALTMANN, as chauffeur for Conrad KUEHLEIN, #KUEHNE, in Washington.

✓ m. # SCHMIDT

Born 1 December 1906 in St. Petersburg,
(Leningrad, USSR)

BDC traces were requested, on behalf of CATIDE, in EGMA-64505, 8 May 1964.

✓ n. # VIERK-WERNER

#GLOECKLER

Born 3 February 1913 in Bessen,
Island of Rügen, East Germany
Residing in Wiesbaden, Mainzerstr. 25a

Early in (1964) he was reportedly a CATIDE operations officer serving under industrial cover in Frankfurt/Main. (See EGFA-41733, 21 April 1964.)

✓ o. # VOGLER

Born 4 May 1921 at Prattling, Bavaria

The wife of Richard VOGLER (see below) and a staff employee, she is to serve as her husband's secretary if he joins CATHINK.

✓ p. # VOGLER

Born 16 September 1928 at Kietzham
near Erding, Bavaria

... was been nominated as CATIDE's chief representative to CATHINK, but it is not clear whether he will actually take the job. He joined CATIDE in 1960.

✓ q. # WALLER

Born 25 November 1926 in Koennendeich/Huell,
(West Germany)
Residing in Nienburg/Weser, Hegenring 65

BDC traces were requested, on behalf of CATIDE, in EGMA-64364, 20 April 1964.

3. Organizational and Personnel Changes

The following organizational and personnel changes have become known to MLB:

SECRET

a. Hans von BUECHLER [] BROCK, told [] in May 1964 that the CE/CI, agent security, and staff security components of CATIDE are supervised by Wilhelm BAUER [], BAYERLE, whose position is more or less on a par with that of Wolfgang LANGKAU [], HOLTEN, who we had thought supervised those sections. This appears to give CATIDE six major organizational units just under the vice-president:

- (1) Tactical collection under Herbert KRAUSE [] REICHLIN (See paragraph 3 f.);
- (2) Strategic collection and other functions, such as personal and foreign liaison, under HOLTEN;
- (3) CE/CI and security, under BAYERLE;
- (4) Evaluation and reports under Gen. Erich DETHLEFFSEN [] DEGENHARDT;
- (5) Plans and administration, including staybehind and war planning, under Horst WENDLAND [] HOLM;
- (6) Communications under Gen. Johannes CROME, [] CAPPEL.

b. On 16 June 1964 HOLM told [] that CATIDE will have completed its building program by 1968, by which time it will have reached its peak employment of 6,000. He said that at present CATIDE employs approximately 5,000 persons.

c. According to BROCK, CATIDE had three CE groups as of January 1964. The primary one was headed by Rolf GRAEBER [] PETERSEN, responsible to BAYERLE. Another headed by Dr. Hans Georg LANGEMANN [], BLUECKRATH, responsible to HOLTEN, handled CE work for the political operations group of Kurt WEISS [] WINTERSTEIN. Coverage of the Chinese Communist intelligence service, apparently the duty of the third group, was supervised by BAYERLE directly.

d. In May 1964 an indications center (Aktuelle Lage) was set up in the military evaluations unit. While Horst NITSCHMANN [] NORTMANN, chief of military evaluations is officially responsible for the functions of the unit, his deputy, Friedrich GRUENEWALD [] GRAU, will actually manage the center, reporting directly to the German Defense Ministry in Bonn and to UTILITY through DEGENHARDT.

e. (1) Heinz HERRE [] DESSAU, was named to replace Conrad KUEHLEIN [] KUEHNE, as CATIDE's Washington representative.

(2) KUEHNE will return to CATIDE in July 1964 to become deputy to DEGENHARDT, in DEGENHARDT's words to [] "to assume active leadership of the Auswertung while DEGENHARDT operates one half step higher".

f. (1) REICHLIN, deputy to HOLM since March 1963, was selected to replace DESSAU as chief of tactical collection.

(2) Hermann LASSEN [] LAMMERT, assumed REICHLIN's job as deputy to HOLM.

(3) Lt. Col. fnu #KULM, formerly in personnel, took over #LANMERT's duties as chief of the war planning section of the plans and administration unit.

g. (1) Otto Harald Andre MORS #MOELLER, #VIKTOR, formerly CATIDE representative in Paris, became chief of foreign liaison on 2 March 1964, vice METZ #MERTENS.

(2) #MERTENS had been scheduled for the CATIDE representational job in Washington until his heart attack early in 1964. He had returned to work by June 1964, but MLB does not know whether full or parttime, or in which unit.

(3) Alfred DUERWANGER , #DIECKMANN, UTILITY's son-in-law, replaced #MOELLER in Paris.

h. Dr. Hans Walter Julius WINTER #WILDEN, who has been in charge of CATIDE's foreign liaison with countries of continental Europe, supervised the entire foreign liaison unit from the time of #MERTENS's illness until 2 March, when #WILDEN moved to #HOLTEN's office in downtown Munich, where he was to handle special agent and foreign liaison connections for UTILITY.

i. (1) #BROCK was scheduled, as of 1 July 1964, to become CATIDE's representative in the Hague circa October 1964. His duties in the foreign liaison section have been divided.

(2) Werner DIPPEL , #DUERER, will handle reports exchange with KUBARK and other services.

(3) The individual who will be in charge of operational liaison and supervise the general trend of KUBARK-CATIDE liaison has not been selected. Fnu #KOLLER, originally slated for the job, has decided suddenly to return to the Bundeswehr. (See paragraph 6-q.)

j. The source evaluation staff in the tactical collection unit has been broken up and its personnel sent in three directions. Gustav Adolf TIETZE #KURZ, chief of that staff, became deputy to Ebruix ZUCK, , #ACKERMANN, chief of agent security. Part of the function and personnel of #KURZ's staff was transferred to the military section, part to the economic-scientific and technical section, of the tactical collection unit.

k. The audio surveillance unit under fnu #BITTMANN was transferred late in 1963 from communications to plans and administration.

l. Major fnu MATTERHAUPT (phonetic), #Hans-Georg MOMMSEN, formerly commander of CATIDE's Special Forces School at Bad Aibling, has replaced Major Wolfgang Ullrich LEHNERT, #HARER, in the unconventional weapons section of army evaluations. (See Paragraph 5-b.)

m. (1) Klaus RITTER #ROEHL, scheduled to leave the Auswertung for a year as reported in Reference A will in fact have a one to two-year leave of absence in order to head a Rand-type organization, a private research corporation under contract to the government. As reported in EGMA-64668, 30 June 1964, #ROEHL may remain permanently with the new corporation if it proves successful.

(2) Ernst Otto Franz ZOLLING [] [], @ZAHN, will assume @ROEHL's functions as chief of political evaluations, as reported in Reference A.

n. Fritz von BOMHARD [] [] BRUHN, former chief of the military section of the tactical collection unit, who suffered a heart attack late in 1962, has returned to work in the personnel unit of CATIDE. MLB does not know whether he is working full or parttime.

o. Waldemar HERMANN-TROSS [] [], @HERTEL, is scheduled to assume the number-two CATIDE representational job in Paris in October 1964, replacing Lt. Col. Guenter REINHARDT [] [], @ROTTMANN, who has held the job since early 1962. Like @ROTTMANN, @HERTEL will also serve as CATIDE representative to SHAPE ACCG.

p. Klaus-Juergen von BENTIVEGNI [] [] @JUERGENS, aide to UTILITY on technical and [] [] matters, is to become number-two man in Rome on 1 July 1964.

q. Werner ESCHENAUER [] [] @EICHENDORF, who formerly held a CE/CI job in Bonn, replaced von BENTIVEGNI as an aide to UTILITY.

r. Dr. Waldemar MARKWARDT [] [], @MARX, was transferred to a Dienststelle prior to January 1964. At Headquarters he had been chief of the Soviet unit in the military section of tactical operations.

s. Hans Joachim von SEELEN [] [], @SEIFERT, who formerly worked for KRAUSE, @REICHLIN, in Dienststelle 11, was, as of February 1964, working in CATIDE personnel.

t. Franz SCHLECHTIZKY [] [], @SCHLEMM, last known to have been chief of the Muernberg Befra from 1959 to 1962, was chief of a Dienststelle located in Munich as of early 1964.

u. Col. Hans Adolf von BLUMROEDER [] [] @BIRKEN, born 5 August 1904 in Sigmaringen, was working in the general armed forces section of military evaluations as of March 1964. A classmate of DETHLEFFSEN, @DEGENHARDT, at the war academy, @BIRKEN worked for CATIDE as early as January 1954, according to MLB's UJVENTURE file. He told the Army liaison officer, however, that he had "just" been G-2 of Wehrkreis Hamburg, so it is possible that his service with CATIDE has been interspersed with regular Bundeswehr assignments.

v. Gotfried FAEHRMANN [] [] @FRONHOFF (or @FROHNHOFF), reported in paragraph 5-3 of EGMA-63952, 27 February 1964 as fnu FAEHRMANN, in a security hold status because of his personal friendship with UJDRONSY, has apparently returned to work. He attended Karl J. HOLBRUNNER's Christmas party with members of the special security group headed by Volker FOERTSCH [] [] @FLEMING, @FRONHOFF resides in Munich, at Holbeinstrasse 7.

W. Frl. fru @PEGNITZ, last reported to be secretary to WENDLAND, @HOLM, has been promoted to Beaman status (lifetime civil service) and was, as of February 1964, an administrative assistant to @HOLM.

X. Graf Goetz von BULLION [] @GOLZ, will leave headquarters foreign liaison for a liaison job in Brussels.

Y. Five girls have left the translation unit of Dr. Wolfram WILSS, [] @WILLE, for other CATIDE assignments.

- (1) Barbara HERRE, @Baerbel HITFELD, daughter of @DESSAU, has left Headquarters for an assignment in Madrid.
- (2) Marianne @MANG has left for an unknown assignment.
- (3) Sybille @SCHARNITZER, English language typist, left early in 1964, reportedly for a job in Paris.
- (4) Dori @SCHLANZ, who in the past has held various jobs outside CATIDE Headquarters, including one with the German Embassy in Ankara, has left the translations unit. Her appearance at CATIDE's party for MLB on 8 June 1964, as a waitress, suggests that she, like the other waitresses, works in UTILITY's office.
- (5) Cordelia @SIEBECK has left the unit, reportedly for only a year.

Z. Gabriele HERRE [], will leave CATIDE's dispensary to accompany her father to Washington. (See paragraph 3-c.)

4. Separations

The following CATIDE employees have left the organization for the reasons stated:

a. Lt. Col. Helmut DRUSCHKOWITSCH, [] @DRUXA, born circa 1909 in Austria, associated with CATIDE's administration and plans unit since 1959, returned to the Bundeswehr on 1 November 1963, to a G-4 assignment at CENTAG.

b. Edith @DRUSCHKOWITSCH, born circa 1919 in Baden/Wuerttemberg (exact place unknown), the wife of @DRUXA, had also been employed by CATIDE, according to EGFA-41839, 28 April 1964. However, ALEJOS learned in June 1964 that she had resigned to join her husband in Heidelberg.

c. fru @FOLGNER, chief of the satellite section of army evaluations, had a heart attack early in 1964 and was not expected to return to the office.

d. Herbert HOESSELBARTH [] born 2 April 1907 at Chemnitz, (now Karl Marx Stadt), East Germany, working in the same CATIDE field base as Oskar REILE [] @RISCHKE, was fired late in 1963 or early in 1964.

e. Kurt HOFMANN [] [], @HAUSWALD, chief of the Soviet and NVA military analysis section in CATIDE's LAURICLE unit, left in March 1964 for a three-year tour of duty with the Special Handling Detachment, SHAPE Intelligence Staff.

f. Dr. fnu @KRUETHER, chief of the GSFG desk in army evaluations, left CATIDE in mid-1962, for unknown reasons.

g. Maj. Wolfgang Ulrich LEHNERT [] [] @HARER, who was retired from military status in fall 1963, was fired by CATIDE in May 1964. An instructor in CATIDE's sabotage school from late 1959 until April 1962, @HARER worked most recently in @DENK's unconventional weapons section of army evaluations.

h. Naval Captain Gunter POSER [] [] @PRECHTEL, who had been chief of naval evaluations at CATIDE since April 1963, left in the spring 1964 to replace Gen. FERBER as chief of joint military intelligence in Bonn.

i. Ernst Ludwig ROSEMANN [] [], @KARLSSON, CATIDE's representative to CATHINK, was fired, as reported in MUNI 9020, 25 February 1964.

j. Carl SCHUETZ [] [], @SCHUSTER, formerly with Dienststelle 24 in Cologne, and a friend of UJDRUM, has been fired, presumably because of his SS record.

k. Naval Captain Hans ("Archie") TRUMMER [] [] @TRUMBERG, was replaced as chief of naval evaluations in April 1963 by POSER, @PRECHTEL. Prior to his departure from CATIDE Headquarters @TRUMBERG had been reported to be slated to become chief of naval intelligence in Bonn. In early 1964 he was reportedly making frequent visits to CATIDE.

l. Ernst-Heinrich ZIMMER [] [], @ERNST, formerly @ZIERER, was planning to leave CATIDE in order to make more money in private business, as reported in EGMA-77354, 23 April 1964. Most recently on the Berlin desk at CATIDE Headquarters, @ERNST was once chief of the Soviet section in the tactical operations unit. He also served for a time with CATIDE's Berlin office.

m. Two persons are known by MLB to have left CATIDE's military evaluations unit to join the Bundeswehr.

(1) fnu FOERSTER, @FEHLAU, chief of East German OB in army evaluations, left in April 1964. He was reported in EGMA-63952, 27 February 1964, to be possibly identical with Hans Joachim FOERSTER [] []

(2) fnu TRAUOGOTT, @THIERSCH, born circa 1923, left the transportation and supply section.

n. Three individuals have left Dr. @WILLE's translations unit.

(1) Paul @BARUM left in 1963 to study at the University of Munich. Although he has continued to work for the unit during his school vacations, he will probably not return full time upon completing his studies, because he intends to become a teacher.

Born circa 1896

in Berlin for many years as leader of Group "H". MLB UJVENTURE
files carry a Juergen JENSEN (probably true name), V #12654, who
joined CATIDE in May 1953 and was last reported working with the
#HOLTEN complex.

- q. fnu #KOLLER (male)
Born circa 1921

Originally scheduled to assume overall supervision of CATIDE
liaison with KUBARK and other services, part of #BROCK's job.
#KOLLER suddenly decided to return to the Bundeswehr which offered
him a regimental command. (EGMT-10865, 22 June 1964, describes
#KOLLER in somewhat more detail.)

- r. fnu #KROEGER (male)
Born circa 1905

in Berlin for many years as leader of Group "A". MLB UJVENTURE
files list Karl KROEGER (true name), born 20 September 1909 in
Bydgoszcz (Bromberg), Poland, who joined CATIDE circa January
1951 and worked for Dienststelle 62 in Berlin during the early
1950's.

- s. Frau fnu #KUHNERT
DPOB Unknown

An other-than-English translator in the translations unit, who
has apparently been there for some time.

- t. fnu #KUMMER (male)
Born circa 1912

with one of the larger operational units in Berlin.

- u. Frau fnu #KUPFER
DPOB Unknown

employed in the office of Dr. #SCHOENHERR, who works for #LUECKRATH
in a special CE unit in the #HOLTEN complex.

v. fnu @MALSUNG (male)
Born circa 1904

railway expert in transport and supply section of CATIDE's military evaluations unit, formerly with the Bundesbahn.

w. fnu @MERAN (male)
Born circa 1925

Brought to CATIDE from a troop unit early in 1964 to replace fnu FOERSTER, @FEHLAU, as chief of East German OB, @MERAN was designated chief of the Soviet section of army evaluations in May 1964.

x. Uli (Ulricke) @MAINBERG (female)
DPOB Unknown

working on Near Eastern political and economic reports in the translations unit.

y. fnu @MOELLENBERG (male)
DPOB Unknown

chief of the atomic research and techniques section of the economic/scientific and technical evaluations unit.

z. Hans @MUNTAU (male)
Born circa 1940

a former translator for a private firm, he has joined the translations unit, where he specializes in technical translations.

aa. Fri. Astrid @MYLIUS
Born circa 1935

in the translations unit.

bb. fnu @PRANNER (male)
DPOB Unknown

working for @LUECKRATH in his special CE unit in the @HOLTEN complex.

cc. fnu @ROSSFELD (male)
DPOB Unknown

a young member of either the tactical collection or the evaluation unit.

dd. fnu @RUDAT (male)
DPOB Unknown

chief of a CATIDE surveillance team.

ee. Frau fnu @SABOTTI
Born circa 1908

has worked for several years for @JENSEN, leader of Group "H" in Berlin.

ff. @SAITNER (male)
Born circa 1922

sub-deputy in the Far Eastern forces section of the combined arms unit of military evaluations, with CATIDE since 1962.

gg. fnu @SCHAUER (male)
Born circa 1917 in Berlin

reported to be in charge of Befra files.

hh. Dr. fnu @SCHOENHERR
Born circa 1912 in Berlin

working at present with @LUECKRATH in a special CE unit subordinate to @HOLTEN, Dr. @SCHOENHERR has been with CATIDE since 1958 or 1959.

ii. fnu @SCHRANZ (male)
DPOB Unknown

analyst on the Czech desk in military evaluations, who entered on duty early in 1964.

jj. Frau fnu @SCHWIEDER
Born circa 1928-1932

an assistant to Volker FOERTSCH, @FLEMING, in the special security group attached to UTILITY's office.

kk. fnu @STADT (phonetic)
Born circa 1928

working for @EICHENDORF, who has replaced @JUERGENS as a special aide to UTILITY.

ll. fnu @TONDA (male)
Born circa 1914

chief of the supply segment of @CARLSSON's transport and logistics section of military evaluations, @TONDA appears to have a doctorate of some variety.

mm. fnu @URBAN (male)
Born circa 1919, probably in North Germany

a member of the naval evaluations section, as of spring 1964.

nn. fnu @WERNER (male)
Born circa 1913

leader of Group "J" in CATIDE's Berlin office.

oo. fnu @MILLIBAND (male)
Born circa 1920

advanced in May 1964 from a job in the East German OB desk to become deputy chief of army evaluations.

pp. Ute @ZECHAU (female)
Born circa 1939

in the translations unit.

7. Corrections

a. In paragraph 2-a of Reference A, Alfred BAROWSKI was listed as a new true-name identification, an individual scheduled to participate in escape and evasion training at SMETRIC in the United Kingdom. [] believes that this is in fact a new alias for Joachim BAHR [] @BACH, a retired Lieutenant Colonel who has served as an operations officer in CATIDE's staybehind program since prior to May 1960. BAROWSKI is the only individual on the list of persons receiving the SMETRIC training whom [] cannot clearly identify, and [] knows that BAHR, @BACH, did attend that course.

b. FrI. Ramona @RAMIN, reported in paragraph 6-4 of Reference A, to be a secretary in the transportation and supply section of

military evaluations, is secretary to its chief, von CRAMER, (201-077279), @CARLSSON. She was born on 15 April 1921, not circa 1935 as reported in that dispatch.

c. Review of additional biographic data from CACROW on Werner STEINIKE, [redacted], born circa 1912 in Berlin, (reported in paragraph 2-q of Reference A), suggests that this is probably Werner STEINKE, @STERN, who has been carried in UJVENTURE files as possibly a CATIDE courier, the husband of Lucie and father of Ines and Susanne, all presently or formerly CATIDE employees.

d. Hans @VOLLNER and fnu @WICHMANN, reported in paragraphs 6-x and -z of Reference A as possible CATIDERS, are in fact representatives of ODUNIT, as reported in EGMW-13508, 9 January 1964.

e. The surname of Richard ZOLKIEWIER, [redacted] born circa 1920, reported in EGMA-61041, 21 January 1963, should be spelled ZOLKIEWICZ. He was born 3 February 1921 in Solotwiz/Galicia, USSR.
