Dr. Martin MUDA is a member of the Czech embassy in WASHINGTON and
chief of the Czech Intelligence Service in the USA.
Simultaneously he works for the Russian Secret Service and is
said to have a direct connexion with the Russian embassy
in Washington. (During the war work had been in Russia and
from this time date his relations to the Russian Secret Service).

According to my informant MUNK is corruptible and it would
thus be possible to get the entire Czech and perhaps even parts
of the Russian espionage net in the USA into our hands. Important
is, that the man, who had already once bribed MUNK and
would probably be able to carry through such an action once more,
is living in LONDON at present, and intends to emigrate to
Australia by the end of this month. In case a like action
would be of interest, urgent information and order is requested
so that the man can be kept from starting his travel.

Re: proceedings of Landeshaupmann Heideck: HECKE,
Dr. Anton FLEINER and Dr. Emil von FOASSL,
interview by, Lapid - Willi.

By I repeat my request to hasten up the intervention in these
three cases as much as possible. HECKE should be transferred
to the OIG and be released afterwards, getting town: report in
London. HECKE is urgently needed for the line Mount Vernon,
for which he managed several branches in which he cannot be
replaced in the moment.

Dr. Anton FLEINER is the best man of the line Mount Vernon in
Upper Austria. At present, he is charged with a special
investigation of Landeshaupmann HEISSNER and his Communist
connexions. FLEINER cannot be missed, not even for ever so short
a time.

Dr. von FOASSL has brought recently a new very promising UJIA-
line and even before that he had been a very good agent. His
case is especially urgent, as he has received already the
recognition according § 10 and 11, though not the date of the
proceedings.
