SPEARHEAD, AMCON

- A. HOETTL SAYS FRED MEYER AMERICAN PARACHUTIST CAUGHT PROBABLY EARLY APRIL THENSBRUCK. HIS WIRELESS OPERATOR ESCAPED.
- B. GAUBERTER HOPLER WANTED USE MEYER CONTACT TYPOL ANDI HAZE RESISTANCE MOVEMENT AND PROBABLY AMERICANS ALSO.
- C. OSTUBAF HELPER OF THENSBRUCK STAPO OFFERED TURN OVER AMERICAN OPERATOR PREVIOUSLY CAPTURED TO HELP MEYER CONTACT AMERICANS.
- D. MEYER AND A WILLIAM SLASH TARE OPERATOR NOT CLEAR WHETHER A NAME AS IN CBAC CMA WERE HELD BY HOETTL TO REACH SWISS BORDER.
- E. HOETTL DOES NOT KNOW WHETHER THEY ARRIVED SAFELY AND DOES NOT KNOW DETAILS OF ATTEMPTED CONTACTS RESISTANCE MOVEMENT OR AMERICANS.
