The following is furnished for information and any action deemed necessary. Internal Security Branch, OMB, may be interested in the future.

It is noted in French intelligence reports of individuals whose location is sought by French authorities was left with Intelligence Section, OMB, for processing.

Amongst others, request status of Wilhelm HERTZ, former attachment to OMB, and his wife, was requested.

An informal note at the bottom of the request, - probably left inadvertently in the hands of Intelligence Section - indicates that one of our people knew that HERTZ was responsible for the transfer of HERTZ and his wife to Austria into Switzerland.

Consider intelligence reports from HERTZ, which are quite numerous, there is nowhere an indication that US authorities are acquainted with the information about the matter.
