Interview: Mr. Lucid-Willi

The plan was discussed with Mr. Heiss, the chief-manager of that factory and he agreed. He will clear up the details with Willi, especially Willi's future position in the factory, so that the latter will be able to take a strong influence on the employment questions, especially which persons are to be chosen for salesmen abroad. This would render a possibility of a far-sighted planning for our intelligence work. Mr. Heiss promised to write a memorandum about the whole plan of his factory and its necessities, so that then further details can be discussed.
