Specific - CDEUM Interest in Austrian Intelligence Circles

Summary: Dr. Schneider, ODEUM Chief, recommends creation of a US dominated intelligence rocf organization in Austria to oust the influence of Dr. Wilehlm HOETTL, former SD personality inimical to ODEUM activities through Austria. Schneider candidate to head such an organization: former General LAHCUSEN. Recommended action: FPM discussion with

- 1. Developments in the intelligence field in Austria are a matter of primary interest to ODEUM since many of their operations are dependent on lines extending through Austria. The fact that the US agencies have sponsored the growth and reestablishment in Austria of elements of the RSHA which are inimical to Dr. Schneider and his project has long been a subject that prompts most vehement reactions from Schneider. He particularly deplores the support that has been given to Dr. Wilhelm MOETTL whom he considers to be a man of such low character and poor political record that his use for intelligence activities, regardless of how profitable they may be, is a short-sighted policy by the US.
- 2. It is a recognized fact that USFA Intelligence agencies have substantially backed the intelligence activities of Wilhelm HOSTIL, Karl von WINKLER and other former German and Austrian Intelligence personalities linked with them in war and post-war intelligence activities. Major MILANO stated in the spring of 1949 that this group, now in some way politically connected with Herbert/MIANOS' 4th party, has received approximately \$200,000 from USFA since the end of the war.

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- Initially, I was inclined to dismiss Schneider's consistent stacks on HOEPTL as being personal bias resulting from the historical analysis between the SD and the Abwehr. However, conversations in Karlsruhe, 15 June 1949, threw considerable new light on the entire matter. Ispent months interrogating HOETTL, UNCAN and others involved in intelligence activities in Austria and the Halkans during the war, but had only recently heard that their reestablishment in the intelligence field was being sponsered by US agencies. His statements contained conclusive evidence of the undesirability of any US agency supporting HOETTL and his group—particularly in view of the fact that they have, in the past four months, become increasingly active in the political field. Is stated that upon learning of HOETTL's activities he had recently initiated a letter to FEM outlining his reactions to HOETTL during the extensive interrogation in 1945.
- 4. Several weeks ago I suggested to Schneider that he reduce his views on the Austrian situation to writing. A few days after that I talked with who was in Munich discussing the relationship of Mus to the vienna station, and informed him that I would forward Schneider's views to FPM in sufficient time to ensure that he could discuss them with the appropriate FBM staff members prior to his return to Austria.
- 5. The attached study, Proparatory Measures for the Future Organization of an Austrian IS Under the Fredominant Influence of the United States, was prepared personally by Schneider. It is obviously written solely from the comply point of view but may contain some thoughts of interest to ______ Although I have read it carefully. I do not feel qualified to comment without further examination of CDMUM's Austrian situation. _____ stated that he also knew LANCUSEN and that his interrogation in 1945 revealed no derogatory information.
- 5. I note that the ODENN files contain an extensive dossier of current information on HOETIL and his present connections. The volume of this file and the fact that it is in German precluded its inclusion with this dispatch.

INCL-1 Dr. Schneider's comments on the future organization of an Austrian IS, dated 14 June 1949

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Preparatory Passures for the Future Organization of an Austrian IS Under the Predominant Influence of the United States.

I. . Situation in Austria

The situation in Austria is characterized by the fact that several groups are operating there in the field of intelligence activities (see Annex 1). Some of these groups pursue the aim of eventually being incorporated into the IS of a future Austrian Federal Republic. The various Allied Intelligence Services, i.e., the American, French, and Tritish, cooperate with some of these individual groups and are equally interested in the solution of this question, particularly in security themselves the predominant influence on the Suture Austrian IS.

Politically the Austrian situation is characterized by the fact that a peace treaty is unlikely to be forthcoming, unless the Allies are willing to accept demands of the Soviete which would allow them to penetrate the entire Austrian area with the aim to bring about the establishment of a Communist regime. The Austrian Government in Vienna operates within the Soviet orbit. There can be no doubt that it is the scales the Soviets to seize upon the legal representatives of the Austrian Covernment, particularly Herr RECOURT, President of Austria, at a propitious juncture, in order to initiate, under pressure, a "legal" conversion of the Austrian State into a Communist regime.

Precurably the present trend will come to a certain conclusion, for the time being at least, in a division of Austria with the establishment of a Western Austrian Government, which at best will be formed by the escaped legal representatives of the present Austrian Government in Vienna.

II. Ways to Friablich a Poture Austrian IS Under the Predominant Influence of the United States

None of the groups at present operating in the field of intelligence activities in Austria is so important that it can claim for itself the sole candidacy to form the future

Austrian IS. The problem takes on an even more complicated number since three of the groups, i.c., those of NOETTL, UNBALL-RANKER, and WINCHESS-1005, originated from the Reichssteherheitehauptast, SD, and are organized along the lines of the directives issued before the end of the war by SS Oberfuehrer SCHELLEM ERG, and thus will probably not make Austrian and European interests their primary goal. If a predominant US influence is to be secured from the very beginning, the methods of either supporting individual organizations in such a way as to make them the most effi-cient of all, or inducing the Austrian Government officially or inofficially to back up one of these groups, are ruled out. The US influence is to be secured subtly and imperceptibly. This can last be brought about by finding a solution, which would eliminate an internecine foud between the individual groups by bringing them into line with one another. Therefore, it sooms advisable to choose a procedure similar to that taken by industry in making several enterprises cooperate along a common line with a . view to eliminate a fight against each other. For this purpose it is suggested to establish a common platform for all the major groups operating in the field of intelligence activities in Austria in the form of an "inner circle" so to speak. In this respect, it is on decisive importance that the leadership of this "inner circle" should be entructed to a man who both fits the intentions pursued by us and enjoys such a reputation in the country itself that he would qualify himself for the leading post within the Austrian IS. The representative of the individe I groups to be delegated into this "inner circle" would have to be selected in such a way as to guarantee a majority in the sense decired by us at all times. The former General LAHOUSEM seems test qualified for this mission. Prior to the "Anschluss", MANOUSEM held a leading position in the Austrian IS. Later on, he became the chief of Department II of the German IS, and now lives, under French protection in the French Some of Austria. LAHOUSEM aloo enjoys the necessary reputation among Austrian military circles.

It would not be advisable to delegate the chief of our own Austrian organization into this "inner circle" in order to withhold from the other groups, as far as possible, any knowledge of his activities. He would best be represented in the "inner circle" by one or two qualified coworkers of his organization, whose affiliations must, of course, be kept secret. Herr MADLING would be ready to

function, together with the American gentleman associated with him, as the official exponent of the US, and he would, furthermore, he willing - if that should be necessary and feasible, - to apply for the prerequisite emigration papers.

In view of the four-power control in Austria and the existing international agreement, an official cooperation of this overall IS organization with Allied or Austrian government agencies is out of question, but a clandestine and narrow contact with individual, reliable representatives of the Austrian Government, such an REHMER, President of the Federal Republic, can well be maintained.

In order to be in a position to exercise influence through the "inner circle" and to employ it as a valuable source of information, a limited financial support of it is indispensable. If, for immance, this "inner circle" would have at its disposal about \$10,000 per month, this sum would enable it to exercise a certain central of its intelligence activities by allocating intelligence missions accordingly.

The necessary prerequisite for the success of a solution as outlined above is that no other US agency would coperate with Austrian organizations.

III. Spinnary .

It is proposed that the groundwork for a future overall Austrian IS be laid by the creation of a common reprecentation of all the major intelligence groups operating in Austria, which must imperceptibly be controlled by the US. I with this view in mind, the individuals to be delegated into this representation should be selected in such a way as to guarantee the following:

- (a) The predominance of the US influence;
- (b) A smooth conversion into an Austrian IS agency at a later date.

Consolidation of this influence by a limited financial support granted to the "inner circle" is necessity.

Elimination of other US agencies from the cooperation with the qualified groups (such as MOETTL).

Frief Notes on the IS Groupe Operation in Austria.

1. Tritich ID: KITTEL

Tohemia, of Austrian Nationality, in Roman-Cathelia, single, lives at present at 7 Reisenbergerstrasse in Salaburg. He has a trade licence for dealing in machinery, printing equipment, stamps, and foodstuffs; travels much; goes to England every 3 months. He works for the British IS, was a police official in Vienna prior to World War II, assigned to the German CI in Sofia, where he was in connection with KLATT, alias KLIUDER. At the German surrender detained in the Glasenbach Internment Camp. KITTEL is probably known to the Soviet IS, for a certain GAMMER who had been arrested by the Soviets was ordered, prior to his release, to furnish information concerning both Dr. KITTEL and the inspector of the criminal Police MANDER (Innebruck), connected with KITTEL.

WITTLE maintains business connections with the Dobler Textile Firm in St. Gallen, Switzerland, the Madis & Guenther Firm in Bregens, and the William SWIDER Import and Export Inc. in Eucrich.

No information is available to this project concerning Count LEDMBUHR.

2. Pranch IS

Information concerning Austria is furnished to the French IS by a certain Adolf JAHROVIC, an ethnic German, formerly a high-renking leader of the Hitler Youth (Dann-fuchrer) in Esseg. He left Austria in the early fall of 1948 for the French Zone of Germany, registered at IRO as a Mugoslav, and Jound employment with the Mugoslav "Drile Covernment" formed by IVIIROVIC in Paris. In the late fall of 1948, JAHROVIC returned to Germany and contacted PRAMER (See below), SCHMIBDER, a former Hitler Youth leader at present living in Leipzig, and HEITHARR, purchaser of the Mugoslav Government in Vicana. His superior in the French IS is AlbiJAC in Paris. His Faris address is: Adolpho Faris.

Another agent of the French IS in Vienna is the former SC Od It. /SAUBERS, formerly chief of a section of the Vienna BS Security Service District (SD-Leikabschnitt Wien): His superior is a French major attached to the French Has in Vienna. SAUDERS is connected with PRANTS.

3. IS of the Austrian Federal Army

0eVP (Austrian People's Farty): RONGE, already known to the US agency.

SPOe (Social-Democratic Party of Austria): LINHARDT. Fordigand MINHARDS, age about 95, sorved with the Austrian "Yolkswehr" (People's Army), precurnor of the Austrian Pederal Army; in 1938, he was a captain of the 6th Inf. Rgt. in Krems, was taken ever by the German Army and promoted to the rank of lieutenant colonel. His last assignment during the war was that of a recruiting district commander in Neunkirchen. He is a member of the Austrian Social Democratic Party and had helonged to the "Republikanischer Schutzbund" (a semi-military dramination of the Austrian Social Demoerate). In 1948 he became adjutant to Minister of the Interior Hallin, was detached to the Inspectorate General of the Austrian Police (security mark) late in 1948. He is designated by the Social Democratic Party of Austria for the post of the future Minister of Mational Defense or at least Secretary in this ministry.

4. Roclesiestical IS

No information is available concerning Jesuit father

5. IS of the CeVP (Austrian People's Farty)

Ferdinand GRAF, Secretary in the Ministry of the Interior; chief of the IS of the Austrian People's Party.

/LUKAS, a former National-Socialist, was additor of the "Macrather Grandschutz" under the National-Socialist regime, is GRAF's commissioner for personal information, at the same time drafting his speeches.

Dr. Theodor/WULHRER, living on Landstrauce in Linz, who in 1937 was editor of the Linz "Tagespost", became editor-in-chief of the Mational-Socielist provincial party head-quarters in Seleburg in 1938. During the war, he was assigned

to HEYDRICH's headquarters, thereupon went to Agram, and finally, holding the rank of SS 1st Lt., was chief of the liaison staff assigned to Ambassador NEUBACHUR. After the war, he offered his services to the Austrian People's Party, advancing to the position of chief of the information service of the party organization in Upper Austria. HOETTL and HERMITYER contacted him to make him subservient to their aims. WUEHRER is not taken seriously and is believed to be a Jack of all trades.

5. It of the CPOn (Social Democratic Terty of Austria)

Mational Councillor Dr. Eruno TITEMENANN pages for the "Description of the Austrian Social Democratic Pary. Forn 1905 in Vienna, IL.D., Th.D., at present Section Councillor (Schtionerat) in the Austrian Ministry for Social Administration, is the secretary of the slub of the social ist members of the Mational and Federal Councils (Mational rathund Bundedrat), and in this position exercised considerable influence upon the attitude of the Social Democratic delegates in both houses of Parliament. He is a decided epponent of the left wing of the Austrian Social Democratic Party, which leans toward the Communist Party of Austria. Michigan contacted FITTHMIANN in order to secure a benevolent attitude on the side of the Austrian Social Democratic Party toward the "Verein der Unabhaengigen" - VdU (the nucleus of a fourth political party in Austria) (see HOETTE).

7. IS of the VaU - "Verein der Unabhaengigen"

Identical to the HOETTL IS Organization. HOETTL is known to the US agency.

9. UREAU - RANNER - FROMHLICH Group

VIRIAH, formerly CS licutement colonel, the principal charge d'uffaires of the SS Security Service, Department VI for Hungary; very experienced in the field of intelligence activities, rather brutal in his dealings with subordientes. After the war, interned in the Languager Camp, then worked for CTC. Cince he pursues the same tendency as NOSETA, i. e., to group around him all former co-workers of the Mequartment VI he can reach, he is in opposition to NOSETA.

/MANUER, SS captain in the SU leadrity Corvice, was listen a Ticor of Department VI at "Army Group Couth" to-ward the and of the war. He has a gift for intelligence activities, but is an intrigant and a brutal character. He is a devoted follower of URCAN.

PROPULION, So captain in the SS Security Service, was assigned as an evaluator to NOETH in Hungary during the war, is very intelligent, knows Hungary and Czechoslovakia well, however, he likes to drink; fell out with MOETH on account of his work for UNPAR.

An important co-worker of the URIAN Group is a Dr. FARTIK (or PARTIK) in Vienna, a Sudeten German, a rellying point of the group of the Sudeten Germans in Vienna. De is absolutely in favor of the West, is connected with Wolfram you FORMA and Dr. EXPLIANER in Innsbruck, with a group of former members of the GS led by a certain PAPST in Vienna, as well as with an anti-Colchevist group/led by a certain FMLAGORK in Vienna.

9. WINCKLER = LOUT Group

VINCKIER, Dr. Karl von, advisor of the SS Security Scrvice, Department VI, at the "Army Scoup SouthEast" and in this carneity made the acquaintance of HOETTL. Vicited HIMENIOVIC during the war, after fillegally contacting the British IS, at present officially employed by CIC Vienna, but is probably also connected with the British IS. Mission of CIC Vienna: Activities directed against Yugoclavia.

LOOS, Dr. Roman, was chief of the Secret Field Police attacked to "Army Groups I and F", a good police and IS expert, a specialist in Balkan affairs; he is said to have upoken degisively about HODITE recently.

201 LANG IS Group

TANG, Alexander, an Hungarian; his real name is Count MCRAYSONY, has lived in the Orient for 20 years, entered the British IS, is now active as a British lieutenant colonel in Mlagenfurt; his superior has is MI/8 in Vienna. His field of activities is mainly Hungary and Yugoslavia; he is connected with Hungarian 1st Lt. Harry/SAMMA who, at present, is assigned to a French detachment in Mlagenfurt. One of IANG's co-workers is an English captain with the nickname of OMESIKE.

11. DOEEETS IS Group

Wailable, this group is reportedly of minor importance only.

12. Dr. Brich MUSHAM . John Les Jev

Dr. Erich/MURLIER.works for Paron von ZTHERACH (Director of the Voranlberg Security Service) and for the reactor of the Voranlberg Security Service) and for the French IS. Baron von STHERMACH heads a special department in charge of intelligence activities within the framework of the rolice, which is ultimately controlled by Section Chief (Sektionschef) PALMER in the Austrian Ministry of the Interior.

13. Traditiati

/STUBERNAU, a former member of this project (atill loose connection), works for the French II, in the exponent of the "Verein der Unabhaen, igne" in the Tyrole.

14. RANGS - SAUPP - LUETULNBORF - PLORIAN

The RAUSS - GAUFF. Group is chiefly concerned with the organization of anti-Communist forces on the basis of a future Austrian Federal Army. Whereas General RAUSS, living at Zell amisee, is more concerned with problems of the military organization, GAUPP devotes himself to intelligence activities in connection with an US agency. RAUSS is connected with RONGE.

Georg Ritter von GAUPT-BENGMAUSEN, born in Vienne on 12 January 1918, a Roman-Catholic, formerly a major, at present a head clerk, living at Himmelreich (new building) in Salaburg, is in close contact with you AUPTOBLEOR, a former IS officer, at present living in Groungmain near Salaburg. In the conduct of his intelligence activities, he is furthermore connected with Dr. Frank KAIEPA, chief of the State Velice Popartment at the Galaburg Police Readquarters, and presumably also with Policeirat Plance. The litter passes for the chief of the IS of the Austrian People's Party at the Salaburg Police Readquarters, dAUPF is furthermore connected with Cangolf/ULRICH, chief of the "Communist Party Division" at the Directorate of Public Safety of the Federal Police in Salaburg. GAUPF is furthermore connected with the former major of the mountain troops Walfter Ternhard/MOHRUGSER, who at present is assigned to the customs guard at the Salaburg freight station.

FIGRIAN, who is likewise connected with GAUPP, was until recently a co-worker of this project. He is chief of the IS of the Austrian People's Party in the Tyrole and probably maintains connections also with the French IS.

15. STEINER Circle

Connections reaching into Austria:

KAPPER, owner of a factory, living in Wels, editor of the magazine "Trado and Industry", in which he propagates a German-French approachment. The German representative of this magazine is STEILER.

/CIRK, Walter, SS Captain, living at Kufstein.

NUFFER. Rudolf, living in Graefelfing, contacted on behalf of STEINER the French I S in the Tyrole in Midnay 1949. The representative of the French IS, however, refused his offer.

16. /HAGEN Circle

Formerly an SS brigadier general. no details available.

17. Former Hitler Youth Leaders

Sicaffied/SOHIDER, formerly a high-ranking Hitler Youth leader (Oberbunniachrer) assigned to the Culture Department of the Seich leader of the Hitler Youth, at present living in Salzburg. GCHIDER is connected with Dr. Ernstallwirth, formerly a secretary of legation in the German Himstry of Foreign Aggains; with FRANKIES, the secretary of the Austrian People's Party in the province of Salzburg; with Lational Councillor/GSCHHITTLER in Innsbruck (of the Austrian People's Party); with Eational Councillor/ACFCRETER (of the Austrian People's Party); with Eational Councillor/ACFCRETER (of the Austrian People's Party); with [LEMMARDT, an editor of the "Salz-lurger Machrichten" covering the SU, and with PRANTZ.

At precent, PHANTS is still connected with this project through Hons LAUTERBACHER jr, Munich; both of them are soing to be dropped. PRANTS is also connected with the HORSTE Group through KOWARIK:

PROMSON and MAUFIMANN are also connected with SCHIDER and PRANTS.

Guenther KAUPERCE, formerly a high-ranking leader of the Hitler Youth (Obergebiets fuebrer), lives at present in the French Sone of Jermany and issues the magazine "Das Ufer" (the Shore). PROKSSE, editor, high-ranking Hitler Youth leader, was assigned to the special headquarters of ROSHMBERG in the Ukraine during the war; he is at present a laborer of the aluminium plant in LEMD (province of Salaburg). He is in democation with the Ukrainium politician/PHYMOWSKI, at present living in the UC Cone of Jornany, and knows SKORZEMY very well. Whether he still is in connection with SKORZEMY is not clear. Possibly, he is also connected with the former leaders of the Hitler Youth Fritz/ENTERLANK and Helmut Former leader of the Hitler Youth Fritz/KOCH, in Vienna. KOEL is suspected of being in connection with the EVD.

18. <u>Quiriton Circle</u>

No details available.
