TO : Commanding Officer, 430th CIC Detachment,
Upper Austria Sub Detachment, APO 174, U. S. Army

1. Reference your request, 1 September 1949, attached hereto for your information and action deemed necessary true copies (in triplicate) of Subject's recommendations for a "Centralized U. S. Intelligence Agency" and cover letter to Mr. Richard.

2. The original documents came into custody of this agent, on or about 7 October 1948, when they were brought to Stor by a friend of Subject and former operative of this office, Dr. Thomas HUZILLA. When Dr. HUZILLA stated he was carrying some intelligence reports to the U. S. Legation in Vienna, this agent concluded that it would be injudicious to carry documents of classified nature to the Legation through the Soviet Zone. The CIC message center was recommended as the most expeditious means of transmittal. HUZILLA consented that the documents be removed from their original envelope in order to comply with the two envelope system prescribed for classified matter by AF 3 C-5 and in order to attach an explanatory note for the Chief of Operations, Vienna City Section, to hold the packet for Dr. Huzilla who would deliver it in person to Mr. Richard.

3. The necessary clearance for forwarding the documents to the care of CIC Vienna was obtained from the Commanding Officer, Upper Austria Sub Detachment, after taking precautions to see that true copies were first made. The primary reason motivating this agent to make copies of the documents and to bring the matter to the immediate attention of the Commanding Officer was the knowledge that Subject was in the employ of the 430th CIC Detachment and that the contacting of a private individual, Dr. Allen Welsh Dulles, through the department of State was a matter of trust undertaken without the sanction of the Chief of the employing agency. Subject's conduct seemed all the more reprehensible because many of the comments contained in his letter are purportedly based on knowledge derived from his position of trust as an operative of the 430th CIC Detachment.


