SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

The following information was obtained on 6 March 1950 from confidential informant 10/6357, who has numerous contacts among newspaper correspondents and former officers of the German intelligence. Evaluation: Source "C" (fairly reliable); Information "B" (possibly true).

HOETTL has established contact with the French Intelligence through the former SS Sturmbannfuehrer of Art VI, Werner GOETSCH. GOETSCH was interned by the French in 1945 and since his release he has openly worked for the F.I.S. HOETTL receives GOETSCH in his home very often, and both have been seen in Salzburg on numerous occasions.

FILE CHECK:

Files of this office reveal numerous reports pertaining to Subject.

Report, dated 11 July 1946, mentions Werner GOETSCH, formerly of VI E, concerning a business transaction between him and a Frau Emma KOPP, residing in the Villa Korry, Alt Aussee.
