Erich KERNMAYER

1. Attached is a report on Erich KERNMAYER provided by [ ] from the State Police files in Graz, together with an extract of a supplementary note written by PIKHOFER, the Graz Security Director. The reports are forwarded because, as right hand man to Willi HOETTL, KERNMAYER is of CI interest.
2. At our request, [ ] questioned S/A Zigmund C. YANECKO of the CIC Gmunden Field Office (usually located at St. Gilgen), who has recently been submitting intelligence reports with KERNMAYER indicated as source. YANECKO claims to have met KERNMAYER when he was first assigned to Gmunden prior to the severance of HOETTL's organization from CIC. Since the dropping of HOETTL and KERNMAYER, YANECKO has maintained a casual, friendly relationship with KERNMAYER, who drops by the office occasionally and reports gratuitously bits of information which YANECKO is in the habit of papering in the usual fashion. No money changes hands and no special favors are done for KERNMAYER in return for this information.
