SUBJECT: REINARTZ - Suspected of Intelligence Activity

Date of Information: State of Inquiry at End of March, 1950

General Op. Matters - Austria

The journalist and publishing specialist (fnu) REINARTZ in
HERMSACH in the Tirol worked for the British Intelligence Service in
Bulgaria during the war; he was protected by the German Air Attache,
Colonel SCHOFENBERG. He is related to the (Leutnant) SCHULZE-BOYSEN
who was active in the "Rote Kapelle".

Recently there was a connection between REINARTZ and (Dr.)
WILHELM HOETTL, for REINARTZ served as publishing agent for HOETTL's
book, "Die Geheime Front". But, since REINARTZ' accomplishments fell
far short of his promises, this business relationship has now been bro-
ken off.

In addition, REINARTZ is in contact with Erich REINGLAYR in
GRUNDE; a connection with Colonel WAGNER-DELIUS is suspected. The
part played by one STUMPF, with whom REINARTZ likewise is in liaison,
has so far not been made clear.
