1. The following information is based on a conversation between CC 2 and Dr. Wilhelm HÖTTL.
2. In collecting informations for his planned new book, ~~see~~ report P/03005, dated May 30, 1951, C, HÖTTL applied to (fnu) RÖDER, formerly active with 'Unternehmen Zeppelin', to get from him a report on such activities.
3. On this occasion (fnu) RÖDER informed HÖTTL on alleged preparatory measures for a new German Intelligence Organization. Such organization would be under control of Staatssekretär PLANK and headed by the former OKW Abwehr Lt. Col. (fnu) HEINZE (or HEINTZE). ADENAUER and PLANK not being in favor of the G-Organization want to have an all-German intelligence formed without any foreign interference. Probably because of US request they do not intend to exclude the G-Organization entirely, but will treat it with extreme caution. According to RÖDER's statement, such new intelligence organization will finally be headed not by GEHLEN, but by HEINZE.
4. Since the funds granted to HEINZE for such purpose are small, HEINZE at first can only extend his operations to Eastern Germany.
5. For reporting, both HEINZE and GEHLEN allegedly visit PLANK together and occasionally also ADENAUER.
6. HÖTTL had the impression that RÖDER is a member of the HEINZE organization because of his experience in organizing the partisan groups behind the Russian lines.
