The following information on KRALLERT was excerpted from G-3 USFA files:

1. CIC Salzburg, TWX, dated 21 May 1948.

Subject is KRALLERT, (Dr.) Wilfried, born 23 January 1912, Austrian National. Arrangements for utilization by Historical Division EUCOM of subject have been completed by CSO (DE) representative and Brigadier HOPE of Intelligence Organization, BIA, Vienna. Subject to report to you o/a 25 May 1949 for transfer by waybill to Bad Reichenhall, Germany. Historical Division EUCOM will transmit travel orders to you for his travel from Bad Reichenhall to Frankfurt. Historical Division EUCOM contact is Capt. W. Z. HERRINGTON, Tel: Frankfurt 8823. You will be notified of any changes.

2. Informal memorandum, dated 13 December 1948, Subject: Query by Brig. HOPE.

Major HILGRO and Lt. Col. IRVIN will be ready at any time to brief Brig. HOPE on our Yugoslav nets. Recommend 14 1030 Dec. 48.

Mr. WAGNER's man is believed to be Dr. Wilfried KRALLERT, cartographer, former head of the Wannsee Institute, Admont, Styria. His present address is the Abbey, St. Lambrecht's, Styria.

He is not now employed by Meater, and has not been in the past except as a cultural contact. He is available.

3. British Report No. IB/II/FF/1470/17, dated 30 August 1948, Subject: ~~FOETTL~~, (Dr. Wilhelm - Security Threat. This report states that Dr. Wilfried KRALLERT, SS Stube and former Gruppenleiter Amt VI/C, NSDA, was interrogated in 1946 by the British.

4. No other information on KRALLERT is available in G-3 USFA files.
