2. On those marked with asterisk (\*) we find a lack of readily available background data. It is felt possibly KURITZ's ready access to Grusco, Gragora and Cimolr files could be of considerable aid in getting this task done most easily and thoroughly. Could it be arranged that only background data be copied from available material, on individuals indicated, labeled, and sent here at earliest convenience? We are enclosing a sample sheet prepared on XEROX to indicate that the data we need is fairly meager in nature.

3. You will note we have not included any of the better known fabricators specializing on Hungarian matters, as this is being handled separately by [redacted]

4. We are undecided whether to include Michael REINHOLD and William J. BISHOP in the list. Although it was proven fairly conclusively the former had indirect contact to STRANG and MASCHAK, it is felt this contact may have been unwitting to some extent. In the case of BISHOP, inclusion in this list seems a rather hollow gesture. Perhaps he best fits in the STAPOL-KAMMERM group and should remain under separate consideration. Incidentally, you will note we have not touched on this group herein, as it seems too delicate a matter for the general "burn" technique used in the others. Would appreciate your comments on REINHOLD and BISHOP.

5. Karl Reinhard KRAMER and associates have been held off the list pending the results of debriefings which, we assure, are still under way.

6. It is appreciated that this request places an added burden on an already overworked staff; however, this is not an extremely high priority matter and takes no precedence in your schedule. You will note the basic data we desire is not voluminous. Photo-copies of old Grusco source cards, PQ forms, or project folders may suffice in most cases.

7. Any comments, additions, or deletions on the above would be appreciated.
