In conference with GASSON, [] Toni HALTER and Gen. H. Von
MELLENTHIN, UTILITY stated the following concerning the GIS and its various
comppnent organizations -

Chancellor ADENAUER had decided that the Amt fuer Verfassungsschutz, which ^{is}
under the direction of JOHN (fm), will be responsible for internal security
matters within Western Germany. UTILITY's organization, on the other hand,
will be responsible for continuing intelligence operations in foreign countries.
It was decided at this time that Col. HEINZ should so organize his group that
it can be entirely incorporated within the UTILITY organization with HEINZ
assuming the title of section chief. (There follows UTILITY's description of
HEINZ' past and his faults) Many of HEINZ' subordinates are former SS or SD
people. For example, SS Major HOETTL, in Austria, is in contact with HEINZ;
within HEINZ' intelligence circle HOETTL is responsible for South Eastern
Europe, Italy and North Africa. Because the operations of HOETTL require
considerable financial support, HEINZ receives British subsidies in addition
to the 50,000 DM which he obtains from the West German Government.
