The following information was obtained on 16 June 1952 by this Acout from Informant 6030, who in turn had obtained the information during the course of a conversation with Erich KERGIAYER:

The former Slovexian Minister of Culture, Professor Dr. Ferdinand FURCASSMY, recently reid a number of visits to Exich AbituMited in Grunden, Upper Austria. Dr. DURCALISKY, who recontly errived in Austria from South America, allegedly stated that very little sympathy for the United States is to be found in Argentina. The present policy of the United States towards the South American countries is fostering a tension which may develop into difficult complications. DURCANSKY is anxious to enlist the aid of Srich K-RUNWYER as KERNWAYER possesses excellent personal contacts among the Slovaks residing in Austria. Within the near future, DURCANSKY is scheduled to take an official vacation in Granden, but in reality he will utilize the occasion to formulate the exact methods to be employed between DURCANSKY and KERCHAIER for future joint operations. DUNCANSKY is allegedly employed by some unknown American are per (20181666) REMISSIVEL PLACE PLACE A short time age Dr. Wilhelm HOLTL approached DURGA'SKY in Linz, Upper

Austria, and introduced himself as the representative of a verman office. Americas to enlist the aid of DURCANSKY, HOETTL stated that he was looking for qualified, trustworthy Slovakians who would be trained by him and be well paid for their services. These recole would be employed to obtain political and military informs. tion from the Eastern Zone of Austria, Czechwalowskia and Hungary. HOETTL stated that he is kept busy in Linz naintaining contact with agents who have been assigned to Szechoslovakia and Vienna. HOETTL told DURCANSKY to think the proposal syer carefully and then write an ensure to his (NCETTL's) co-worker, Daron Harry 1457 Post Office Box 331, Main Post Office, Linz, Upper Austria.

Ferdinand DURCAISKY is listed in numerous reports as the former foreign minister in the cabinet of the Slovakian Pupper Coverment which collaborated with the Germans from 1940 to 1944. DUBCANSKI is also mentioned as directing the formation of a Slovak Liberation Committee.
