4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

The following information was received from Informant 3709 who received the information from various intelligence contacts operating in the Salzburg area:

Informant reports that SUBJECT is presently working as an intelligence operative for a newly formed German Intelligence Organization. SUBJECT is working directly under one (fau) GEMME, a former German Intelligence Officer. SUBJECT, a former German Intelligence man who has been engaged in intelligence activities for various countries since the end of the war, visited Bonn, Germany about two months ago in an attempt to clear himself of the charge of having misappropriated funds from the German Intelligence Service during the Nazi regime.

Since SUBJECT's return from Bonn, he (SUBJECT) invited one Peter BOGDON alias CONSTANTINESCU to visit him on 27 September 1952 in Grunden, Land Upper Austria, in order to obtain BOGDON's support and cooperation in connection with his intelligence activities.

Another contact of SUBJECT's group is (fau) FILMER, a former SD Sicherheitsdienst - (German Security Service) man. FILMER, who spends most of his time in the Innsbruck area, maintains close contacts in Bonn intelligence circles. FILMER allegedly received 6,000 Schillings from SUBJECT during October 1952 which constituted his first payment. Approximately two weeks ago SUBJECT had another conference with FILMER and BOGDON at the Hotel Anstriedl in Grunden.

General (fau) GEORGE, leader of a Russian exile group in Munich, Germany allegedly instructed BOGDON, who is GEORGE's representative in Austria, to work closely with SUBJECT's group.

One (fau) HOFFMANN allegedly serves as SUBJECT's liaison between Munich and Bonn.

Informant was unable to establish for which German intelligence service SUBJECT is working and who is financing this newly formed group.
