SUBJECT: "Hitler's Paper Weapon"

1. The attached book "Hitler's Paper Weapon", written by Wilhelm Hottl, and the accompanying note were received from the field for transmittal to the Director for his retention if he so wishes.

2. The Vienna station dispatch stated that Hottl had sent two books to the American Ambassador in Vienna with a note requesting that he accept one for himself and asking him to send the other to the designated recipient. It is presumed that the Ambassador must have accepted one of Hottl's previous books and had probably written him thanking him for it, and that Hottl therefore sent him this new book of his.
