"Gaupressereferent" (Gau Kurhessen from 1934 - 1935 and "Hauptamtsleiter" within the Reichsfuehrung der deutschen Studentenschaft (Hauptamt) Presse, Film, und Propaganda, from June 1935 to September 1936, recipient of the Golden HJ Badge. SA Truppenfuehrer 1928 - 1935. "Hauptamtsleiter" fuer politische Erziehung and "Presseamtsleiter" of student body at Marburg University, 1934 - 1935. On 10 November 1939 he voluntarily joined the SS Verfuegungstruppe Germania, but was released on 25 November 1939 for duty with the Reichsministerium fuer Volksaufklaerung und Propaganda. From 1 December 1939 to 31 January 1941, with this ministry as "Volkstumreferent" for "Volkstumfragen in Suedosten." In 1941 - 1942, he was "Berater fuer Propagandafragen" with the German Embassy in Bucharest. According to an article in the Bukarester Tagblatt in February 1942 he left Bucharest for service with the Waffen SS.

Since 1945, while not a member of any political party, Subject makes no secret of his intense German nationalism; he belongs in the extreme rightwing lunatic fringe of politics. This is evident in his public utterances and writings.
