SUBJECT : Request for Extradition of Nestor Holejko

REF :

There is enclosed in the original and in English translation, supplied by the Ministry its Note no. 109.978/65-5 dated May 10, 1965.

The Note requests the extradition of one Nestor HOLEJKO, allegedly now resident in the United States. According to the note, Holejko was an agent of the German security police and later the Gestapo during German occupation of Czechoslovakia and was instrumental in causing the arrest and execution of a number of Allied parachutists and Czechoslovak resistance fighters.

Enclosed with the Note is an official translation of the warrant for Holejko's arrest together with photostats of documents forming the basis for the warrant.

In delivering the note to the reporting officer, Mr. Jaromir PRIZYL, charged with American Affairs in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, stressed the serious nature of the charges and expressed the hope that the request for extradition would be honored.
