SUBJECT: HOLEJKO, Nestor

1. Reference is made to the telephone request dated 23 May 1960, of [] for information concerning Nestor HOLEJKO. The files of this office contain the following information concerning one Nestor HOLEJKO who is believed to be identifiable with the subject of your request.

2. A report dated June 1950 from a usually reliable source described HOLEJKO as a middle aged, bald headed, with only a fringe of darkish hair around his head. He reportedly was of Ukrainian origin and had lived in Czechoslovakia until 1945 when he escaped to Austria or Switzerland. The then largely Communist controlled Ministry of Interior in Prague formally demanded his extradition from Switzerland if he were found there. HOLEJKO allegedly denounced Czech patriots to the Nazi occupants during World War II; he allegedly was also a Trotskyite. The report added that HOLEJKO was working with a left wing Socialist group and with the French Intelligence Service in Innsbruck, Austria.
