SUBJECT: HOLEJKO, Nestor

- 1. Reference is made to the telephone request dated ing information concerning one Nestor HOLEJEO who is believed to be identifiable with the subject of your request.
- 2. A report dated June 1950 from a usually reliable source described HOLEJEO as a middle aged, bald headed, with only a fringe of darkish hair around his head. He reportedly was of Ukrainan origin and had lived in Czechoslovakia until 1945 when he escaped to Austria or Switzerland. The then largely Communist controlled Ministry of Interior in Prague formally demanded his extradition from Switzerland if he were found there. HCLEJKO allegidly denounced Czech patriots to the Mazi occupants during World War II; he allegedly was also a Trotskyite. The report added that BOLEJKO was working with a left wing Socialist group and with the French Intelligence Service in Innsbruck, Austria.
